PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

An employer is not in employer default if thas entered into a repayment agreement with the insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

PROJECT APPROACH



WV School for the Deaf and Blind CEFP Planning and renovations related to future local funding will be for the development of designs appropriate to meet the needs of the County and the accompanying construction administration services. Based on current SBA policy, the SBA and the School will undergo the initial planning process for all the school projects. Alpha Associates, Incorporated provided architectural and engineering design for a 4,864 square foot addition to Ridgedale Elementary School. The addition replaced an existing courtyard and consists of five classrooms, two ADA compliant toilet rooms and a storage area.

This is the third project Alpha has completed at Ridgedale Elementary for Monongalia County Schools.




In the fall of 2015, Columbus City Schools ("CCS") contracted Cooperative Strategies, formerly DeJONG-RICHTER, to update their 2002 facilities master plan to address remaining facilities that needed attention. Throughout the process, over 5,000 community members were engaged through a series of seven (7) community meetings and related online questionnaires.

Our team used enrollment, facility, community data, and feedback from an initial survey in order to create options that would be viable. Using this data, the team along with CCS personnel and an Ad Hoc Committee made up of parents, community members and community officials, created options which were presented to the community at five (5) different locations throughout the city. All of the data used by the Ad Hoc Committee was available on a project website for the community to view.

Through paper surveys at the meeting and an online survey made available for a few weeks after the meeting, the Committee was able to collect feedback regarding the options, which was then used to develop recommendations. These recommendations were presented at two (2) additional community meetings, where feedback was again solicited via paper and online survey.

After reviewing this feedback, the Ad Hoc Committee voted unanimously to proceed with the recommendations and present them to the Board of Education. The Board voted to amend the 2002 Facilities Master Plan and adopt the 2016 Facilities Master Plan Update in June of 2016. As of the fall of 2016, CCS has completed 46 new or fully-renovated facilities in Segments 1 through 3A of the Ohio School Facilities ("OSFC") Program since 2002.



TRIWAY LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT Wooster, OH




Cooperative Strategies was contracted to conduct a facilities master planning process for Triway Local School District ("TLSD") in the summer of 2017. The goal of this process was to improve aging facilities with funding assistance from the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission ("OFCC"). Another objective was to streamline TLSD's overall operations.

A steering committee composed of parents and other community members assisted in the development of options which were shared with the community for feedback. Four (4) packages were developed with a wide range of capital costs, consolidations, new facilities, and operational savings. The committee narrowed the field of options down to two (2), which were then presented to the board for action.

A challenging factor in this process was the construction of a 12-mile natural gas pipeline in the area during the planning phases. This created major implications for funding and community support as TLSD could not anticipate the new tax revenue the pipeline would generate.

TLSD has plans to put a 30+ million dollar bond issue on the ballot for its voters in 2019. If successful, this will lead to the consolidation of at least one (1) elementary school and one (1) middle school, and the construction of a new middle/high school as well as an additional elementary school.



CAMPBELL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS Rustburg, VA



Through a collaborative effort, Cooperative Strategies assisted Campbell County Public Schools ("CCPS") in the creation of a facilities master plan. The primary emphasis was to assist in the development of the overall process with facilitation of a districtwide steering committee. Our firm had continual involvement with School Board work sessions and community dialogues, with the final objective being formation of facility options as well as developing priorities and drafting recommendations.


The facility master plan, strategic in nature, constructs long-term goals and objectives that impact the quality of education in the school district and builds a better vision and future for the community. To arrive at these conclusions, our process included:

- Geographic Information Systems

- · Recommendations determination

Based on the data collected through facilities assessments, input from an Educational Framework Conference, GIS, and other factors, we were able to compile a list of facilities options for CCPS. These options identified which buildings to keep, modernize, consolidate, replace and/or discontinue, along with preliminary budget cost estimates for recommended improvements using a 10-15 year implementation plan.

SHENANDOAH COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS Woodstock, VA



Cooperative Strategies was retained by Shenandoah County Public Schools ("SCPS") to perform attendance boundary redistricting and complete a facilities master plan. SCPS is a rural, county-wide school district in northern Virginia, with approximately 6,100 students. The challenges included aging facilities and an imbalance of utilization across the district. The goal of the first phase of the project (redistricting) was to lower utilization in the northern and central campuses, and increase utilization in the southern campus. In the second phase, we developed a plan that would modernize SCPS facilities over the next 15-20 years. To execute the facilities master plan, the following tasks were performed, with the resulting recommendations below:

- Geocoding students
- Enrollment projections
- Capacity assessments
- Condition assessments
- Educational adequacy assessments
- Community engagement


Boundary Changes: Short-term boundary changes were made to solve over and under-crowding issues.
