### **Attachment A: Cost Sheet**

#### A.1 Payment Terms

A.1.1. An amount representing ten percent (10%) of the contract resulting from this RFP for the Cyber Security Risk Program line item one (1) shall be withheld by the State. Upon formal acceptance by the State of the Cyber Security Risk Program, the State will release the retainage. Upon termination of the contract for reasons other than awarded vendor's uncured material breach of Contract, retained fees for accepted work will be released.

#### Post Implementation Hourly Consultant Rate

The Post Implementation Hourly Consultant Rate (item two (2) of the A.3.3. Attachment A: Cost Sheet) must be a single hourly rate that will be billed for all staff time and is to be used to consult with vendor staff on unforeseen issues related to the Cyber Risk Program that may arise after the Cyber Risk Program has been successfully implemented. Requests to use the Implementation Consultant Hours must be outlined in a SOW (Statement of Work) and include both the problem and required number of hours to address the problem, and must be executed by an authorized representatives of both Parties. The Post Implementation Consultant Hours will not be allowed to exceed one-thousand (1,000) hours.
