

CRFQ GSD20*22 Question and Response 01/17/2020

Q: The answer to question #1 in Addendum 1 states "the majority of the carpet glue and mastic was removed by chemical solvent and mechanical scraping." By utilizing a chemical solvent, the VCT manufacturer will require a bond breaker to provide separation from the recently chemically abated substrate. However, the bond breaker material manufacturer will not warranty their product due to the chemical residue. The only way to ensure we can obtain a warranty to provide the Owner, the entire floor area would have to be bead blasted. Can the warranty requirements be lifted, or should we include bead blasting in our proposal?

A: The Agency will not lift the requirement of a 5-year warranty for the chosen vinyl composite tile. The Agency understands that there can be multiple approaches to achieve the desired results. We have not prescribed a specific product that is required to be utilized in the process of preparation of flooring for installation. The Vendor shall ensure that the warranty requirements can be met with their chosen process of installation. In the "Purpose and Scope" section of the GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS the Agency has indicated that "Vendor shall furnish any incidental work, materials, labor, and equipment that are necessary to complete the Construction Services, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the Project Plans."

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or second five percent of the total contract amount.
