STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA Purchasing Division PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

To that end, Grainger requests the opportunity to clarify certain terms contained in the enclosed offer to ensure that our compliance with this contract, should it be awarded to Grainger, and your customer satisfaction are achieved. Noting that Grainger would like to confirm that the State shares the same understanding for contract compliance on the following terms and conditions from the bid.

General Terms and Conditions

- **28. Warranty:** In regard to subsection (b) Grainger, as a distributor and not a manufacturer, would like to confirm that the "purpose intended" by the State is consistent with the purpose intended by the manufacturer for the product.
- **30. Privacy, Security and Confidentiality:** Grainger, while it sells MRO, and may not be thought of as digital company does have significant on-line presence and experience in digital sales transactions. Our company has a robust data security policy and would also like to confirm that since this contract applies to gas sensors and does not cover the use of any personal information, that this clause does not apply to this agreement.

Specifications Section

- **6.1 Delivery Time:** Grainger can ship orders received before 4pm the same day that they are received. We believe that is most cases we can get emergency orders to the purchaser within one day, but it may not be possible in all cases in remote or extremely rural areas.
- **6.2 Late Delivery:** If an order is place through the Grainger government team at 1-800-GOV-TEAM, the purchaser will be notified if an order is delayed. However, stocking will be tailored to the needs for the product in the bid so it is not anticipated there will be any delayed orders.
