

On page 5 of the bidders instruction it stated that there was a mandatory pre-bid and instruction for each were listed in specifications. We noticed that in the addendum #1, a company was asking if they could bid after the fact. Just checking this to see if it correct?

Answer: The pre-bid meetings were changed from Mandatory to Non-Mandatory in Addendum #1

Question: Will there be permits and B & O tax required?

Answer: We are unfamiliar with the requirements for permits or B & O taxes. It will be the responsibility of the Vendor to determine this information.

Cooper's Rock:

Question: At the site visit it was discussed that the duck work would be changed to separate the two current systems so that they would stand alone. Should we include this work in our bid?

Answer: Yes, this work should be included. This question highlighted an error with our last specifications. The following changes shall be applied:
