




Trade-In Rebates

Resellers may take advantage of rebates when customers purchase new Alaris scanners and trade in their old Alaris or other manufacturer scanners.

Eligible Products and Rebates

- Products and rebates are in the attached charts.
 - o Trade-In with Service values may be claimed if
 - Product being traded in has a current Alaris service contract which has been in effect for at least six (6) months.

OR

a multi-year Alaris Care Kit is purchased with the new product.

OR

- a one-year or multi-year contract is purchased when trading in other manufacturers' equipment.
- An approved Deal Registration may be required; this will be identified in the charts.
 - o If an opportunity qualifies for Deal Registration, it must be registered.

Recycling

- If a reseller is trading in more products than they are purchasing, Alaris will pick up all scanner products at the same time and recycle them. No additional rebates will be paid on the additional units picked up.
 - o Example: Reseller is trading in 3 i1860 scanners and purchasing 1 i5850 scanner
 - Reseller will earn the rebate for the 1 scanner purchased (if requirements are met)
 - Alaris will pick up all 3 i1860 scanners and recycle them at no charge.

Process

- Alaris will then contact the end user with shipping information.
 - Products will be picked up from ONLY the end-user's location
- Alaris must receive Traded-in products within 60 days of the Reseller invoice date for the new product.
- Trade-In credit will not be issued until receipt of product by Alaris and new equipment purchased.

Scanner Packaging and Pick-Up

- Scanners being traded in that are equal to or less than 125 lbs. require the end user to supply packaging and package the scanner for pick- up.
- Alaris recommends use of the packaging material from the newly-purchased product.
- Alaris may send UPS Labels instead of arranging for truck pick-up.
- Products that are equal in weight and size to the i600 series through the i1800 series scanners DO NOT require end user packing. Alaris will arrange for pick-up.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (*W. Va. Code* §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
