

SPECIFICATIONS

- PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Division of Highways, Department of Transportation, to establish an open-end contract for a (WVDOH Class 841) Trailer Mounted Portable Traffic Light. Horizon Signal SQ3TS or Equal, VER-MAC TLD-3612G3 or Equal, North American Traffic PTL 2.5X or Equal.
- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 2.1 "Contract Item" or "Contract Items" means the list of items identified in Section3.1 below and on the Pricing Pages.
 - 2.2 "Pricing Pages" means the schedule of prices, estimated order quantity, and totals contained in wvOASIS or attached hereto as Exhibit A, and used to evaluate the Solicitation responses.
 - **2.3** "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
 - 2.4 "WVDOH" means West Virginia Division of Highways.
 - 2.5 "EPA" means Environmental Protection Agency.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.1 Contract Items and Mandatory Requirements: Vendor shall provide Agency with the Contract Items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract Items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements as shown below.

- 3.1.1.7 Unit signal arm extension shall be adjustable with the ability to extend the high mount light out a minimum 160-inches.

3.1.2 Battery and Charging

- 3.1.2.1 Unit shall have a minimum of 16 AGM batteries.
- **3.1.2.2** Unit shall have a minimum solar battery charge rate of 500 Watt.
- 3.1.2.3 Unit solar panels shall have the ability to lay flat.

3.1.3 Hydraulic

3.1.3.1 Unit overhead mast shall be hydraulic lift with push button Control.

3.1.4 Lighting and Detection

- 3.1.4.1 Unit shall have a minimum 12-inch diameter LED signal lights.
- 3.1.4.2 Unit shall be equipped with a traffic detection system.
- 3.1.4.3 Unit shall be equipped with a rear facing LED light 4-inch

minimum diameter, that lights green when green signal is active and red when red signal is active.

- 3.1.4.4 Unit shall have DOT approved indicator lighting.
- **3.1.4.5** Unit shall be equipped with 7-way round pin trailer connector.

3.1.5 Miscellaneous

3.1.5.1 Unspecified Accessories & Features: All parts, equipment, accessories, material, design and performance characteristics not specified herein, but which are necessary to provide a complete unit must be furnished with each unit and required to conform to strength, quality of material, and quality of workmanship to those which are advertised and provided to the market in general by the unit industry. All parts and accessories advertised and regularly supplied as standard shall be included, except those which would represent duplication of these specified and except those which, by specification, are not to be furnished. All standard safety features, required by Federal and State Law, shall be included.

3.2. Vendor Responsibility:

3.2.1. The vendor is responsible to furnish a portable traffic light that is properly engineered and that confirms to all and any laws governing such equipment.

3.2.2 Representative Unit for Test:

3.2.2.1 The successful vendor must (if specified) provide the DOH one (1) completed represented unit to be observed and evaluated on each order to in-sure compliance with specification. If requested, the time period for testing and evaluation shall be seven (7) working days following receipt of the unit. DOH will incur no obligation for deterioration of surfaces, finishes, seals, and mechanical or electrical parts on the unit resulting from operation and testing within the limits of these specifications; nor will DOH

incur obligation for damage to the unit resulting from failure to meet specifications when due care and attention is given by DOH and testing is done within the limits of these specifications. Failure of the pilot unit to satisfactorily meet specifications as bid may be cause for cancellation of the purchase order and return of the delivered unit along with all associated equipment to the vendor at the vendor's expense.

3.2.3 Operating and Service Manuals and Parts Lists:

3.2.3.1 An operator's manual must be included with each unit upon delivery. A "line sheet" (if applicable) and the "Equipment Preventative Maintenance Questionnaire", (Exhibit "B") must be with pilot unit upon delivery, Attn: Todd Campbell. There must be 12 service/shop/maintenance manuals and 14 parts manuals; USB storage drive is preferred in lieu of parts manuals. Manuals and USB storage drive shall be delivered upon completion of delivery of total units. Failure to do so will delay payment.

3.2.4 Training:

3.2.4.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to stage a thorough seminar on the subjects of Preventative Maintenance, Operator, and Mechanic Training. In order to keep operators and mechanics updated, the successful vendor shall conduct training sessions covering the operation, maintenance, troubleshooting with each purchase order against this open-end contract.

3.2.5 Preventative Maintenance & Operator Procedures:

3.2.5.1 Manufacturers and/or dealers will be required to submit to the Equipment Division, in addition to the operating and service manuals, booklets and pamphlets explaining the Preventative Maintenance and Operator Procedures to be used by the operators of this equipment, and must include such things as daily prestart inspection procedure, service schedule, and routine maintenance required, safety precautions, etc. The successful vendor shall furnish all training aids; i.e. videos, projectors as required in conducting the training.

3.2.6 Warranty and Service Policy:

3.2.6.1 The bid shall include a breakdown of the complete manufacturer's warranty per section. The unit must be accompanied upon delivery by the unit's manufacturers standard warranty and service policy.

4. CONTRACT AWARD:

- **4.1 Contract Award:** The Contract is intended to provide Agencies with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 Pricing Pages: Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages by (Exhibit A) by completing the Year, Make, Model, and inserting quoted unit price. Vendor should take estimated Quantity and multiply by unit price to get grand total. Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages in their entirety as failure to do so may result in Vendor's bids being disqualified.

The Pricing Pages contain a list of the Contract Items and estimated purchase volume. The estimated purchase volume for each item represents the approximate volume of anticipated purchases only. No future use of the Contract or any individual item is guaranteed or implied.

5. ORDERING AND PAYMENT:

- 5.1 Ordering: Vendor shall accept orders through wvOASIS, regular mail, facsimile, email, or any other written form of communication. Vendor may, but is not required to, accept on-line orders through a secure internet ordering portal/website. If Vendor has the ability to accept on-line orders, it should include in its response a brief description of how Agencies may utilize the on-line ordering system. Vendor shall ensure that its on-line ordering system is properly secured prior to processing Agency orders on-line.
- **5.2** Payment: Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:

- 6.1 Delivery Time: A completed pilot model for inspection must be provided within thirty (30) working days after receipt of the pilot model order, by the successful vendor. Vendor shall deliver standard orders within ninety (90) working days after orders are received Working day is defined as any weekday, Monday thru Friday, excluding Federal and State Holidays. Vendor shall ship all orders until a minimum delivery quantity is met.
- 6.2 Late Delivery: The Agency placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if orders will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the delayed order, and/or obtaining the items ordered from a third party.
 - Any Agency seeking to obtain items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Purchasing Division.
- 6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss: Standard order delivery shall be F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location. Vendor shall include the cost of standard order delivery charges in its bid pricing/discount and is not permitted to charge the Agency separately for such delivery. The Agency will pay delivery charges on all emergency orders provided that Vendor invoices those delivery costs as a separate

- 6.4 Condition of Unit(s) Upon Delivery: All units must arrive at the prescribed delivery point having been completely pre-serviced with oil, lubricants, and coolant. All prescribed precautions pertaining to first operations and break- in of the unit are to be posted conspicuously on the unit for ready observance by the operator.
- **6.5 Delivery Point:** Delivery point of the completed representative unit will be the WVDOH, Equipment Division, Rt. 33 and Brushy Fork Road, Buckhannon, WV 26201.

7. VENDOR DEFAULT:

- 7.1 The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.

- **8.2** Vendor Supply: Vendor must carry sufficient inventory of the Contract Items being offered to fulfill its obligations under this Contract. By signing its bid, Vendor certifies that it can supply the Contract Items contained in its bid response.
- 8.3 Reports: Vendor shall provide quarterly reports and annual summaries to the Agency showing the Agency's items purchased, quantities of items purchased, and total dollar value of the items purchased. Vendor shall also provide reports, upon request, showing the items purchased during the term of this Contract, the quantity purchased for each of those items, and the total value of purchases for each of those items. Failure to supply such reports may be grounds for cancellation of this Contract.
- 8.4 Contract Manager: During its performance of this Contract, Vendor must designate and maintain a primary contract manager responsible for overseeing Vendor's responsibilities under this Contract. The Contract manager must be available during normal business hours to address any customer service or other issues related to this Contract. Disclosure of Interested Parties to Contracts

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 6D-1-2, a state agency may not enter into a contract, or a series of related contracts, that has/have an actual or estimated value of \$1 million or more until the business entity submits to the contracting state agency a Disclosure of Interested Parties to the applicable contract. In addition, the business entity awarded a contract is obligated to submit a supplemental Disclosure of Interested Parties reflecting any new or differing interested parties to the contract within 30 days following the completion or termination of the applicable contract.

For purposes of complying with these requirements, the following definitions apply:

"Business entity" means any entity recognized by law through which business is conducted, including a sole proprietorship, partnership or corporation, but does not include publicly traded companies listed on a national or international stock exchange.

"Interested party" or "Interested parties" means:

- (1) A business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract, including specifically sub-contractors;
- (2) the person(s) who have an ownership interest equal to or greater than 25% in the business entity performing work or service pursuant to, or in furtherance of, the applicable contract. (This subdivision does not apply to a publicly traded company); and
- (3) the person or business entity, if any, that served as a compensated broker or intermediary to actively facilitate the applicable contract or negotiated the terms of the applicable contract with the state agency. 





 - LED signal indications are warranted for a period of five (5) years from date of manufacture.
 - Signal Controllers are warranted for a period of two (2) years.
 - Battery Chargers are warranted for a period of two (2) years.
 - Batteries and tires are covered by the manufacturer's warranty. All warranty claims should be addressed through the manufacturers as HST does not warrant these items.
 - Hydraulic components are warranted for a period of one (1) year from date of manufacture.
- 5. This warranty does not apply to a product that has not been installed or maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, has been subjected to damage in an accident, abused or neglected during operation, repaired or modified by persons other than the manufacturer, its employees or authorized agents, or failed to have normal maintenance.
- 6. The buyer expressly agrees that the buyer's sole remedy and the manufacturer's sole responsibility, in respect to a warranty claim, is exclusively limited to repair or replacement at the manufacturer's option of product or a portion thereof found by the manufacturer to be defective. The manufacturer is not responsible for labor or other expended charges by buyer including transportation charges and shall not be liable for any incidental or consequential damages connected with repair of a product deemed to be defective or with installation or replacement of repaired product. Further, the manufacturer disclaims any liability for any incidental or consequential damages, including lost or duplicated time or expense accruing for any reason, to the owner or user of any products sold by the manufacturer, whether claim is made in contract or in tort or under any theory of warranty, negligence or otherwise.
- 7. Subsequent Owners. Horizon Signal warranty covers the retail purchaser and all subsequent owners of the equipment during the specified warranty period. Should you sell this equipment it is therefore important that you complete the warranty registration form (attached above) and deliver the warranty document to the buyer so that the new owner can sign the registration form and forward it to HST Service Department to obtain the remaining warranty benefits, if required.
- 8. The terms and conditions of the warranty cannot be altered without the written consent of the manufacturer.
