SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Water and Waste Management, to establish an Open-End contract for Maintenance and Repair of YSI Water Quality Meters.
- **2. DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - **2.1 "Contract Services"** means Open-End Maintenance and Repair Service Contract for YSI Water Quality Meters as more fully described in these specifications.
 - **2.2 "Pricing Page"** means the pages, contained wvOASIS or attached hereto as Exhibit A, upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Contract Services.
 - **2.3 "Solicitation"** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
 - 2.4 "WV DEP" means the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection.
 - **2.5 "YSI"** originally known as Yellow Springs Instruments, YSI is now a trademark of Xylem Inc.
- **3. QUALIFICATIONS:** Vendor, or Vendor's staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:
 - **3.1.** Vendor must be certified as an authorized service center for YSI water quality meters.

4. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

4.1 Mandatory Contract Services Requirements and Deliverables: Contract Services must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements listed below.

- **4.1.1 Maintenance and Repair Service** This contract shall provide for all labor, materials, equipment, supplies, and incidentals required to maintain and repair water quality equipment.
 - **4.1.1.1** Vendor must perform a free evaluation upon receipt of instruments.
 - **4.1.1.2** Vendor must send a detailed evaluation report and price quote (including freight charges) within ten (10) working days via email to point of contact.
 - **4.1.1.3** Vendor will only perform repairs based on approval received from WV DEP. All repairs must be completed and returned to WV DEP within thirty (30) calendar days after approval is received from point of contact.
 - **4.1.1.4** Vendor must return all repaired instruments with a calibration report to confirm that system parameters meet factory specifications <u>www.ysi.com</u>.
 - **4.1.1.5** Maintenance and repair service will be compensated at an hourly rate. Yearly contract hours will be estimated by WV DEP. Hours estimated are used for evaluating purposes only. No guaranteed quantity of hours is assumed, provided, or implied.
 - **4.1.1.6** All repair services must have a minimum ninety (90) day manufacturer's warranty on labor.

4.1.2 Parts

- **4.1.2.1** All replacement parts used in the repair must be factory authorized parts.
- **4.1.2.2** All replacement parts must have a minimum one (1) year manufacturer's warranty.
- **4.1.2.3** Vendor must send a detailed price quote (including freight charges) for parts within five (5) working days via email to point of contact.

4.1.2.4 Parts will be paid at cost plus mark-up. Vendor should provide the mark-up in terms of a decimal multiplier, as per the following example:

4.1.2.4.1 Place decimal point in front of percentage digits to add to one (1). Vendor should then multiply their multiplier by the parts cost estimated by the WV DEP to arrive at the total for parts. The parts cost is only an estimate used for evaluating bids. No guaranteed quantity of requested parts is assumed, provided, or implied.

4.1.3 Shipping and Freight Charges

4.1.3.1 All shipping and freight charges will be paid based upon actual shipping costs.

5. CONTRACT AWARD:

5.1 Contract Award: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Contract Services. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor

that provides the Contract Services meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.

5.2 Pricing Page: Vendor should complete the Pricing Page by entering their pricing information into WV OASIS. Vendor should complete the Pricing Page in full as failure to complete the Pricing Page in its entirety may result in Vendor's bid being disqualified.

Vendor should fill out Exhibit A Pricing Page by providing hourly rate and parts multiplier. Vendor should enter Total Bid Amount of Exhibit A Pricing Page into Commodity Line of wvOasis.

- 6. **PERFORMANCE:** Vendor and Agency shall agree upon a schedule for performance of Contract Services and Contract Services Deliverables, unless such a schedule is already included herein by Agency. In the event that this Contract is designated as an open-end contract, Vendor shall perform in accordance with the release orders that may be issued against this Contract.
- 7. **PAYMENT:** Agency shall pay hourly rate for Maintenance and Repair Services, and a cost plus mark-up for parts only, as shown on the Pricing Pages, for all Contract Services performed and accepted under this Contract. Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.
- 8. FACILITIES ACCESS: Performance of Contract Services may require access cards and/or keys to gain entrance to Agency's facilities. In the event that access cards and/or keys are required:
 - **8.1.** Vendor must identify principal service personnel which will be issued access cards and/or keys to perform service.
 - **8.2.** Vendor will be responsible for controlling cards and keys and will pay replacement fee, if the cards or keys become lost or stolen.
 - **8.3.** Vendor shall notify Agency immediately of any lost, stolen, or missing card or key.
 - **8.4.** Anyone performing under this Contract will be subject to Agency's security protocol and procedures.

8.5. Vendor shall inform all staff of Agency's security protocol and procedures.

9. VENDOR DEFAULT:

- **9.1.** The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.

 - **9.1.2.** Failure to comply with other specifications and requirements contained herein.
 - **9.1.3.** Failure to comply with any laws, rules, and ordinances applicable to the Contract Services provided under this Contract.
 - **9.1.4.** Failure to remedy deficient performance upon request.
- **9.2.** The following remedies shall be available to Agency upon default.
 - 9.2.1. Immediate cancellation of the Contract.
 - **9.2.2.** Immediate cancellation of one or more release orders issued under this Contract.
 - **9.2.3.** Any other remedies available in law or equity.

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va.
