

Questions from vendors for CRFQ DEP 22*22 HAZWOPER 40 Hour Training

Q.1. The prior communications indicate a total of 60 persons to be trained for HAZWOPER. If these employees are scheduled to attend the week long sessions at our location, we can provide a basic price.

If we would be expected to travel to locations throughout the State, we would need to know in order to determine any necessary off site fees to cover added costs.

A. There are about 50 employees that need training initially and then the agency will need training as new employees are hired (approximately 10-30/year). (Section 3.1.1.7)

Trainings can be provided either at vendor's location or a DEP location, at the vendor's discretion.

If vendor chooses to conduct trainings at DEP location, per person price must be inclusive of any incidental costs. No additional payment will be provided for travel. (Section 3.1.1.3.1)

<u>COMMENT:</u> The HAZWOPER Courses offered at the Regulatory Training Center are designed to meet the requirements of OSHA CFR 1910.120.

In as much, there are a number of DEP employees that have previously been trained on the 40 hour course and only require the annual 8 hour refresher as prescribed within the OSHA regulations. This is the reason for the inclusion of 8 hour course information on the price quote.

Regulatory Training Center HAZWOPER (29 CFR 1910.120)

<u>Definition of HAZWOPER</u>: Topics covered include a brief review of the purpose of 29 CFR 1910.120 regulation, identification of the five classification levels and responsibilities. Definitions of hazardous materials and conditions.

Confined Spaces: Topics include determination and classifications (Permit or Safe), purpose of 29 CFR 1910.134 regulation, Monitoring techniques, Retrieval methods, Attendant duties, general safety considerations.

<u>Legal Requirements</u>: Topics include brief coverage of RCRA, SARA, CERCLA, Applicable NFPA, DOT and Chemtrec information <u>Safety Data Sheets</u>: Topics include coverage of the sixteen sections, terminology, physical and health information and value of information. The application of GHS requirements for labels.

<u>Toxicology:</u> Topics include terminology, routes of entry, symptoms, dose / response relationship, first aid measures, local and systemic effects, acute and chronic illness, etc. Also included is Bloodborne Patheogens.

<u>Personal Protective Equipment</u>: Topics include the four levels identified by OSHA, general safety considerations, permeation and limitations, Respiratory Protection

Incident Command System: Topics include history of ICS, level identifications, roles and responsibilities.

DECIDE Process: Decision making model

Monitoring and Testing: Topics include identification of direct read equipment, purpose and applications, testing and calibration requirements, methods of use and purposes.

Environmental Impact: Topics include recognition of variables that may cause environmental impact, resources for evaluation, short term and long term effects.

ZONES: Identification of zones and purposes

DECON: Topics include methods, set-up, purpose and general safety considerations.

Spill Control and Mitigation: Topics include purpose, methods, equipment and general safety considerations.

Waste Processing and Clean-up: Topics include brief identification of 40 CFR requirements, labeling and identification as well as general safety considerations.

Communications: Topics include methods of communications, resources such as SDS, AAR reference, NFPA Quick Guide, ERG Book, DOT Placards, NFPA 704 labeling

Review of lesson

EXAM (computer exam multiple choice)

Course content is covered in increasing degrees of detail as necessary for 8 Hour Refresher, Awareness Level Training, 16 Hour Operations Level Training, 24 Hour Operations and Emergency Response Level Training.

40 Hour Technician Training utilizes the same subject matter with greater detail, Includes a Hazardous Materials Manual, and a current Emergency Response Guidebook as well as it incorporates the opportunity for physical exercises with equipment and role playing in a controlled environment.
