PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of West Virginia Department of Administration to establish a contract for the one time purchase of one (1) JLG 800AJ HC3 (or equal) Telescopic Boom Lift for the General Services Division located at 1900 Kanawha Boulevard East, Charleston, WV 25305. Machine must be delivered, assembled and set-up on site, vendor must provide training to the agency on operation and maintenance of the unit.
- 2. DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in Section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.

Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.

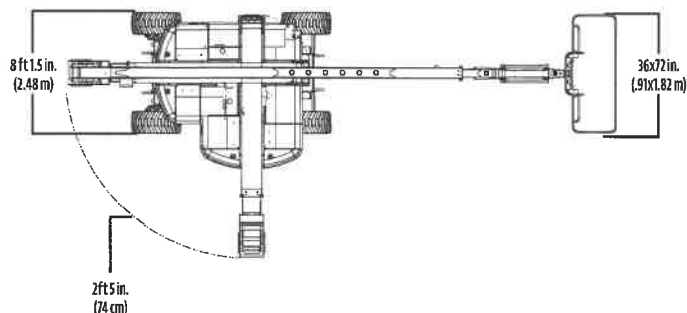
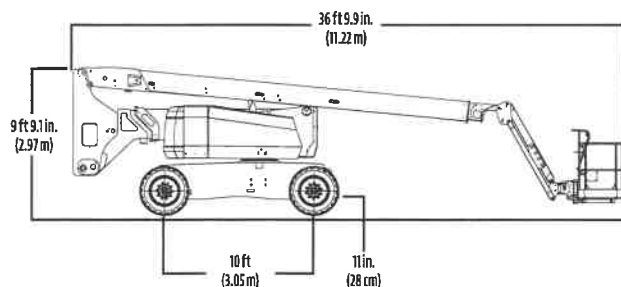

ARTICULATING HI-CAPACITY BOOM LIFT

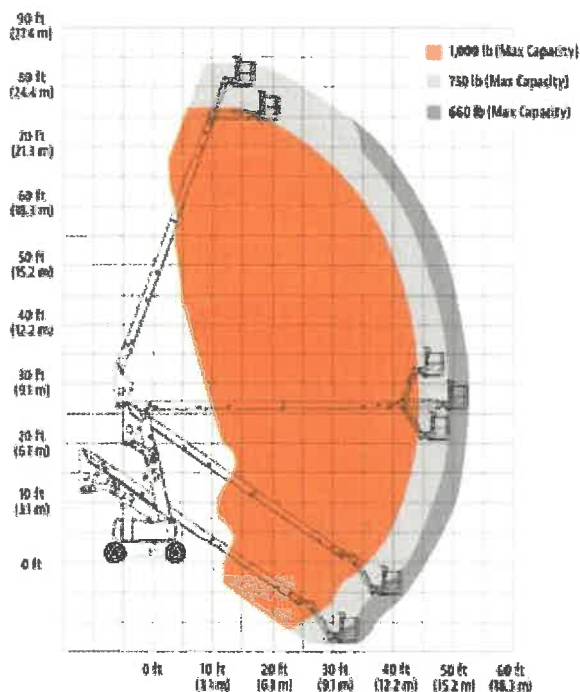
