The air conditioning failure at wheeling has damaged the FM beyond reasonable repair. The unit is 20 years old, no longer supported, and has been quite a troublesome unit in the least few years. I've asked Art to look at this as an emergency, and plan to ask for an emergency purchase. I estimate the \$50,000 range. We have a preferred vendor, but I believe our choice will be whoever can deliver a system the quickest wins.

In the meantime Art is patching together a low power system to provide as much service as we can muster....
