 - 12. Concrete testing is to be conducted by qualified third-party, paid for by Contractor, in accordance with the Project Manual.
 - 13. Egress from the Culture Center Building must be properly protected and maintained throughout the project.
 - 14. Dust Protection will be required.
 - 15. Contractor will be required to submit a Schedule of Values
 - 16. Contractor will have to coordinate fiber relocation dates/times with the Office of Technology to ensure continued/required services. WVOT needs at least two weeks' notice before cable is moved. Coordination with other vendors who have fiber in the existing duct bank may be necessary.
 - 17. Contractor cautioned that the Capitol Police fiber cable is in the

work area and is not to be disrupted.

2. It was noted that the new location is in a book storage area. Dust protection will be needed and the area kept clean.
3. Viewed the Data Room.

5. Looked at the location of the existing communication manhole, the new manhole, and where the duct bank will be located through the lawn area.

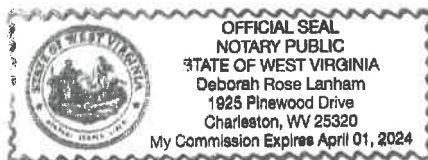

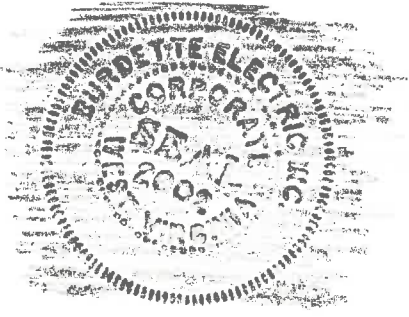
