Any individual that does attempt to represent two or more vendors will be required to select one vendor to which the individual's attendance will be attributed. The vendors not selected will be deemed to have not attended the pre-bid meeting unless another individual attended on their behalf.

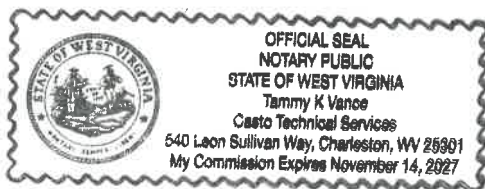

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

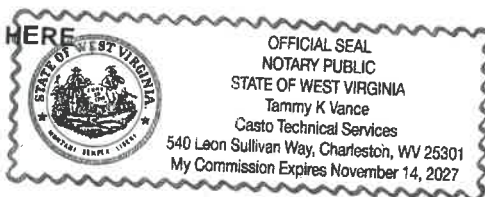

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS (No AIA Documents)

1. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** The West Virginia Purchasing Division is soliciting bids on behalf of the General Services Division to establish a contract for the following:

Removal and replacement of Triad Triumph Gas-Fired Boiler. Replacement boilers must be High-Efficient Condensing Boilers.

The Vendor shall furnish all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to complete all Construction Services. The Vendor shall furnish any incidental work, materials, labor, and equipment that are necessary to complete the Construction Services, even if such incidental work is not explicitly included in the Project Plans.
2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions and in the Project Plans as defined below.
 - 2.1. **“Construction Services”** means removal and replacement of boilers as more fully described in the Project Plans.
 - 2.2. **“Pricing Page”** means the pages contained in *wvOASIS*, attached hereto as Exhibit A, or included in the Project Plans upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Construction Services.
 - 2.3. **“Project Plans”** means documents developed by an architect, an engineer, the Agency, or another design professional, which are attached hereto as Exhibit B, that provide detailed instructions on how the Construction Services are to be performed. In the event that Project Plans contain drawings or other documents too large to attach in Exhibit B, Vendors can obtain copies in accordance with Section 9 of these Specifications.
 - 2.4. **“Solicitation”** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with Construction Services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
3. **ORDER OF PRECEDENCE:** This General Construction Specifications document will have priority over, and supersede, anything contained in the Project Plans.
4. **QUALIFICATIONS:** Vendor, or Vendor’s staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:
 - 4.1. **Experience:** Vendor, or Vendor’s supervisory staff assigned to this project, must have successfully completed at least three (3) projects that involved work similar to that described in these specifications or the Project Plans.

EXHIBIT B – PROJECT PLANS

1. **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS:** Construction Services must meet or exceed the Mandatory Requirements listed Below. All work to be performed per the specifications detailed below. The Vendor shall provide, install, program, and provide staff training as outlined in the detailed scope of work requirements below.
2. **DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK REQUIREMENTS**
 - 2.1. Vendor will uninstall and remove existing Triad Triumph low pressure boiler. Disposal of the units are at the Vendors expense.
 - 2.2. Vendor will replace boiler with current, high-efficiency condensing boilers, that will be approved by the Agency Project Manager (Lochinvar FTX850-N Modulating Boiler with 10:1 turn down, and 75psi relief valve, or equal).
 - 2.3. Vendor will be required to ensure that equipment is compatible with and programmed for operation with the Agencies existing Building Automation System (Trane Ensemble).
 - 2.4. Vendor will be responsible for programming and performing start-up. These activities are required for final acceptance of the scope of work.
 - 2.5. Vendor will, after acceptance, schedule training of Agency personnel on the operation and maintenance of the new equipment.
 - 2.5.1. Vendor will provide Agency with all appropriate manufacturer documentation for operation and maintenance.
3. **PERFORMANCE:** Vendor and Agency shall agree upon a schedule for performance of Contract Services and Contract Services Deliverables, unless such a schedule is already included herein by Agency.
