### ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNICIAN 1

## Nature of Work

Under direct supervision, performs beginning level technical and/or paraprofessional work in the field of environmental enforcement involving routine environmental quality testing and/or treating environmentally regulated field sites to insure compliance with State and Federal regulations. Extensive travel may be required. Performs related work as required.

## Distinguishing Characteristics

Performs routine field work in data collection and/or treatment of environmentally regulated sites.

#### Examples of Work

- Conducts routine field laboratory analysis of designated sites on a prescribed schedule.
- Treats sites appropriately to insure compliance with permit requirements.
- Maintains records of tests performed and inventory of supplies.
- Performs preventive maintenance checks and services on equipment, vehicles and facilities.
- May collect and transmit data via computer to monitoring agency.
- May operates four-wheel drive vehicles.
- May handle toxic or hazardous chemicals.

## Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Knowledge of field laboratory analysis methods.

- Knowledge of permit requirements and the policy and procedures of the agency.
- Knowledge of monitoring equipment and vehicles used.
- Knowledge of the procedures for handling toxic/hazardous chemicals.
- Skill in the use of a computer for collecting and transmitting data.

Ability to maintain records.

Ability to operate a four-wheel drive vehicle.

#### Minimum Qualifications

TRAINING: Graduation from a standard high-school or the equivalent.

#### Minimum Qualifications - cont'd.

EXPERIENCE: Six months of full-time or equivalent part-time paid experience in technical or paraprofessional work in environmental/natural resources.

SUBSTITUTION: Successful completion of an associate degree in environmental technology or related fields from an accredited college or university may be substituted for the required experience on a year-for-year basis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Valid West Virginia driver's license.
