**Wraparound Services
Scope of Work**

1. Performance Period. The performance period for this statement of work is July 1, 2021 – April 30, 2022, unless earlier terminated by either Party consistent with the terms and conditions set forth in the Master Agreement, CMA 0511 2673 BMS1600000003, effective May 1, 2016, between the State of West Virginia, Bureau for Medical Services (BMS), and APS Quality Review, Inc. dba Kepro.
2. Centralized initial wraparound eligibility determination: upon receipt of referral:
 - a. Kepro will immediately refer to the Children's Mental Health Wraparound to begin services within 72 hours of completed referral.
 - b. Kepro will confirm child is a Medicaid beneficiary. If not Kepro will refer to local DHHR for eligibility and enrollment when applicable
 - i. Kepro would assess to determine if each applicant the child has a CAFAS/PECFAS score higher than 90 ;
 - ii. If the CAFAS/PECFAS score is higher than 90 and the applicant has current WV Medicaid, then KEPRO will:
 - 1) Facilitate completion of a CSED Waiver Application
 - 2) Independent Evaluator (IEN)
 - a) Facilitate family's choice of an independent evaluator
 - b) Make referral to IEN, authorize evaluation service, set appointment
 - 3) Upon eligibility confirmation by MECA, follow BMS procedures for completion of Get a Freedom of Choice forms
 - 4) Process enrollment into CSED Waiver
 - c. If the referred child does not qualify for WV Medicaid OR does not have a CAFAS score of 90 or above, then KEPRO will make a referral to BCF or BBH for services per active WV Wraparound policies and procedures.
3. KEPRO will track every referral every step of the way and be able to report weekly where every referral is within the process.
4. When/IF the MECA determines that an applicant qualifies for the CSEDW, KEPRO will facilitate the systems to change the child from the Children's Mental Health funding to the CSEDW Medicaid funding. The providers SHOULD remain the same and the transition SHOULD be seamless for the child/family.

5. **Assumptions/Procedures:**

KEPRO understands that the Department is committed to streamline families' access to appropriate wraparound services in our communities. This opportunity will establish a centralized access point to home and community based services to meet the needs of children who otherwise might be at risk of out of home placement as well as assist those returning to the community from placement.

6. **The Centralized Wraparound Hub includes the following:**

- a. Initial Eligibility Assessments to determine which wraparound program may be appropriate.
- b. Therefore, KEPRO will conduct the following ASO Functions:
 - i. Receive/Maintain referrals
 - ii. Completes CAFAS/PECFAS
 - iii. Initial Eligibility assessments
 - iv. Manage referrals to the appropriate entities per active WV Wraparound policies and procedures
 - v. Manage documentation per active BMS policies and procedures
 - vi. Family and provider notifications
 - vii. Atrezzo program for tracking/reporting
