### Toby:

Please allow this memorandum to serve as written justification for a request for Change Order No. 2 to increase the above referenced contract with Chapman Technical Group per the attached documentation. The additional services that are being requested are due to existing circumstances with the renovations to the North and South Gardens. The new industry resources exhibit to be installed on the south property will be integrated with the existing sidewalk and open area.

Change Order #2 would provide additional architectural and civil engineering services to integrate the South Garden ADA access with the exhibit. Seeking competition could result in significantly increased costs to the project and compromise public safety by delaying the construction phase that is essential for ADA access compliance.

We are requesting an increase of \$17,000.00 for additional structural design, surveying, landscaping, safety feature lighting, stormwater management, and grading to connect the exhibit display areas to the South Gardens.

Original Contract Amount: \$ 179,000.00

Change Order No. 1 \$ 0.00

Change Order No. 2 \$ 17,000.00

New Contract Amount: \$ 196,000.00

The net change to this contract by change order, including this request, is \$17,000.00, or 9.5% of the original contract award value. No extension of the contract time is being requested to accommodate any of this additional scope of work.



Dear Ms. Suppa:

As requested, we are pleased to provide you with a proposal for additional services to the above referenced project. Chapman Technical Group would provide additional architectural and civil engineering services required to integrate the South Garden ADA access with a new Industry Resources Exhibit.

Based on our conversations and emails, we understand the new outdoor exhibit will be installed on the south property and will utilize the majority of the currently open area. There will be ten display spaces featuring a different industry: railroad, salt, coal, oil and gas, iron and steel, chemical, timber, glass, clay, and agriculture. A gently-sloping, meandering sidewalk will connect the display areas and direct visitors through the exhibit. It will also provide access to the South Plaza, approximately twelve feet below grade. The display areas will need flood lighting and possibly power and water service. The long sidewalk will need pathway lighting, appropriate seating areas and landscaping to complete the visitor's experience.

The WVDACH will appoint a separate Exhibit Consultant to design the specifics of each display space, including artifact placement, interpretive elements, and visitor interfaces. Chapman Technical Group will work with the consultant to integrate their display design into the south property in terms of location, size, elevation, and infrastructure needs.

This proposal would modify our scope of work to include:

- Surveying the remaining south property and the western wall of the site.
- Grading display spaces, connecting sidewalks and required retaining walls.
- Stormwater management of the exhibit.

- General flood lighting for the display spaces. Specialty or theatrical lighting would need to be addressed by others. If power is needed at each of the exhibits, this will be the responsibility of the Exhibit Consultant.
- Pedestrian pathway lighting and additional seating areas.
- Additional structural design for the overall site, as more of the site will be excavated or altered.
- Additional landscape design.
- Coordination time with Owner's Exhibit Consultant.

Chapman Technical Group is currently working on the North Garden and design development is well underway. We understand the WVDACH would like to release one construction package for the North and South Garden renovations and a construction completion date of January 2024 has been expressed. Adding this additional work will be challenging; however, we will work diligently to integrate the new exhibit and the Garden Renovations Project to meet your goals.

We proposed to complete the additional services outlined above for seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000.00).

We appreciate the opportunity to be of service to the WV Division Arts and Cultural History and your consideration of this request. If you have any questions or need additional information, please contact me.
