The WVDEP Office of Abandoned Mine Lands and Reclamation is issuing a change order to increase the original contract according to all terms, conditions, prices, and specifications contained in the original contract including all authorized change orders as shown on Attachment

A price increase is necessary to perform additional engineering and design services, including revising the existing conditions for the plan sheets to accurately represent recently obtained asbuilt drawings information and the field survey and verification thereof. On Site 1 of this project, due to previously unknown and unanticipated failures of existing AML systems, additional identification, evaluation, the design for the replacement of an existing mine seal is needed. Due to that newly required work, various changes to already completed work was necessary. Additionally, the landowner requested design changes to the proposed reclamation plans. These were deemed necessary to properly addresses previous AML reclamation work to attempt to achieve pre-existing conditions. AML deemed these understandable and acceptable requests for modifications in the design and detailing of proposed underdrain systems and drainage features in the land-owners yard. On Site 2, after detailed reviews of the originally proposed mine seal and horizontal directional drilling (HDD) mine seals to dewater impounded mine water, it was deemed appropriate to revise the originally accepted designed and detailed AML reclamation concepts, means and methods. These needed revisions significantly impacted the already completed designs, construction plans and specifications, although they were deemed an absolute necessity for safety during construction/reclamation activities and to provide for a more viable and longer-term reclamation plan for the dangerous conditions. This included removing the underdrain systems, relocating the previously proposed HDD pit site and design, and for adding an additional HDD site and design. An additional result of these noted changes, the surface and subsurface drainage features and systems require redesign. Partially prepared permit applications (such as WVDOH MM-109, WVDEP DWWM NPDES Construction Stormwater, etc.) including designs, calculations, drawings, specifications, etc., must be revised for the newly proposed reclamation plans, etc. Additional contract time to perform the additional services beyond the current date of completion is not necessary, thus will be unchanged.

(POTESTA) is pleased to provide this Addendum Number 2 and proposal to the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP), Office of Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) for additional engineering and design services for the above-referenced AML project. Our proposal is based on project scope of work changes discussed at the September 13, 2022 Design Meeting Number 2 at WVDEP's Bridgeport office.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

POTESTA's proposed scope of services for this addendum is as follows:

Task 11 - Additional Services and Scope of Work Changes

On September 13, 2022, Tim Rice with POTESTA attended Design Meeting Number 2 at WVDEP's Bridgeport office. The scope of work was changed from the conceptual plan and two preliminary plans that were submitted. This additional work associated with these changes included the following:

- Inclusion of additional information on the plans that was shown on the as-built 1. drawings from the previous AML reclamation project at this site.
- Relocate the bore pit on Site 1 to the opposite side of County Route 22/4. 2.
- Redesign of Channel A to a depth of six feet at the seep collector per landowner 3. request.
- Revise the curtain drain on Site 1 per landowner request. 4.

- Add a Modified Wet Mine Seal on Site 1. 5.
- 6. Remove the Curtain Drain on Site 2.
- Relocate the Bore Pit on Site 2. 7.
- Include an additional HDD and bore pit on Site 2. 8.
- Survey stakeout of gas line and Channel A in accordance with the request from 9. Equitrans Gas.
- Collect Additional Piezometer Readings prior to final design. 10.
- Revise HDD details to include 16-inch steel pipe and 12-inch SDR 35 PVC pipe. 11.
- Revision to the MM-109 permit application and National Pollutant Discharge 12. Elimination System (NPDES) storm water permit application in accordance with the above items.

COST ESTIMATE AND SCHEDULE

Our detailed manhour and cost proposal for Task 11 is shown on the attached Table 1A. POTESTA's proposed cost for this Addendum Number 2 is \$28,780.
