



Please let this memorandum serve as justification for our request for Change Order # 8 to our contract with Swope Construction Co. for the referenced contract. This request is to increase the contract in the amount of \$89,679.78, per the documentation attached to the header of the OASIS document, and the explanation given below.

This increased scope of work is to address three Change Proposal Requests (CPRs) for Building 4 and turn those requests into Change Order 8. Change Order 8 will include the following CPRs:

CPR#45R2 – Adds RATH communications to the elevator modernization of this building (as the elevators involved in the renovation of Building 4 were not part of the larger Elevator Modernization Projects). This will allow the Agency to tie in these elevators with the other elevators from the two Elevator Modernization Projects, which also use RATH.

CPR#50 – Adds break metal on the sides of the storefront at the front inside vestibule. When the old storefront was removed (per work scope of the project) it left a considerable gap in the existing marble (which is to remain) at the head and jambs, which needed to be "covered" with some kind of material. The new storefront will be installed slightly forward of where the existing was removed in order to meet ADA clearance requirements, thus the reason there is a gap in the marble. The original submission for resolution involved replacing with new marble (granite) to match existing, but this cost was over \$19,000. We opted to find a cheaper material and decided to go with a metal which matches the material of the new storefront and will act as an extension of the storefront. This was a considerably less costly resolution.

CPR#51 – Removes limestone slab from exterior wing wall and replaces it with existing slab on site. This stone was approx. 3" out of skew from the plane of the wall and was quite glaring

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being at the top corner of the existing wall. It also had what appeared to be two rebar rods penetrating through the panel which could not be removed without leaving 1" diameter holes in the face of the panel. Thus, the reason to have them remove this panel and replace it with another panel which had been removed from an adjacent location on the building.
