Description of Action/Purpose of Procurement

Change Order 9, which increases the contract for Building 4 Renovations by \$59,493.07, from its current value of \$29,301,312.781 to a new total of \$29,360,805.85, is required to cover the following additional scope items required to complete the project:

- 1. Security access to areas in the building (basement level) for areas that need to be restricted to Agency personnel for mechanical purposes;
- 2. Replacement of additional failed windows and caulk beyond what was indicated in the original solicitation, but discovered during construction to have flaws;
- 3. Installation of protective corner guards where tiled wall surfaces abutted drywall corners;
- 4.To fill a gap between the new sidewalk and the building, to prevent a trip hazard;
- 5. Adjustments to ceiling heights due to needed space for ductwork in the elevator penthouse and the basement, in addition to the construction of a wall in the elevator penthouse for safety concerns;
- 6. Installation of additional heat and smoke detectors in elevator shafts for elevators to pass inspection (Fire Marshall required change from original plans).

The change order also includes a contract extension of 36 days to accommodate the additional work and to cover delay in work coordinated with WVOT and HVAC Commissioning agent. Extension does not delay substantial completion nor building occupancy.

Funding for the increase comes from existing Appropriated funding for Capital Outlay. All costs are vetted against existing contractual terms (AIA, A201 and WV Supplementary Conditions) regarding change orders.
