Dear Mr. Richards:

GRW is hereby requesting an official extension of our Building Commissioning Services contract and Purchase Order (see attached) with the West Virginia Army National Guard, for the BUCRC Phase II Addition/Alteration project, Buckhannon, WV, originally issued 9/21/2020, but funded only for the design portion of the project. As the construction contract for the project has now been issued (8/29/2023), please extend the period of the GRW contract for commissioning services during the project construction phase to 8/29/2025.

GRW will adhere to the terms of the original proposal, but due to the intervening 4 years that have passed in today's unusual economic climate, with little prospect for improvements in the next two years, pricing must generally be increased to cover the inflation impact on our team. The original negotiated total Scope of Work was for \$98,985.00 in September of 2020. Per the agreement and subsequent contract, this project was broken into the initial award, which was for \$39,675.00 for the commissioning services on the Design portion of the project. Then, the agency obtained additional Federal funding for the construction portion of the commissioning services, and the remaining \$59,310.00 was to be added by Change Order to reflect full Scope of Work. However, since the additional funding receipt extended the contract well beyond the original negotiated estimated time period in 2022, GRW is requesting additional fees to compensate for the cost inflation in providing these commissioning services in the amount of \$6,090.00, bringing the total amount to be added to the contract in this change order to \$65,400.00. The current insurance certificate is attached.

Exclusions:

- Building Plumbing Systems, except for Domestic Hot Water heating and plumbing pumping systems.
- Fire Protection, Fire Alarm and other Life Safety Systems.
- Communications and Data Systems, except for the mechanical and electrical building management and control systems.

• Process equipment and systems.

Electrical Distribution Commissioning is limited to transformers and electrical
panels and does not include such items as grounding systems testing, sub-meter
testing, generator testing, ATS function, vibration testing, insulation resistance,
continuity tests, motor phase rotation, GFCI receptacle tests and others.
