SOW Change Order – Unit rate increase due to Consumer Price Index (CPI)

1. Introduction

This Change Order ("**Change Order**") to the Statement of Work for State of West Virginia Statement of Work - Mainframe Svc.pdf having a SOW Effective Date of August 24, 2022 (the "**SOW**") and governed by that certain State of West VA - NASPO Participating Addendum Led by the State of Utah.pdf having an Effective Date of August 24, 2022 (the, "**Agreement**"), is entered into as of April 01, 2025 ("**Change Order Effective Date**"), by and between State of West Virginia ("**Client**") and Ensono, Inc. ("**Ensono**"). 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Consumer prices up 2.3 percent from April 2024 to April 2025

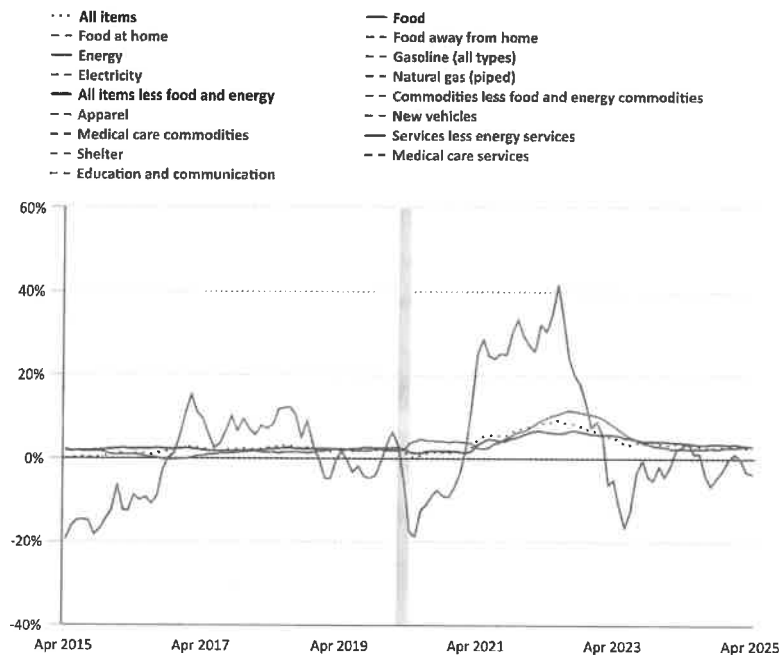

The Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 2.3 percent for the 12 months ending April 2025, after rising 2.4 percent over the same period in March. The April change was the smallest 12-month increase in the all items index since February 2021.

The all items less food and energy index rose 2.8 percent over the 12 months ending in April. Food prices increased 2.8 percent, while energy prices decreased 3.7 percent.

Food at home prices were 2.0 percent higher than a year earlier. Meats, poultry, fish, and eggs prices rose 7.0 percent over the last 12 months as egg prices increased 49.3 percent. Prices for nonalcoholic beverages increased 3.2 percent, and prices for dairy and related products were up 1.6 percent. Prices for fruits and vegetables decreased 0.9 percent over the year. Food away from home prices were 3.9 percent higher than in April 2014.

Gasoline prices fell 11.8 percent over this 12-month span and fuel oil prices fell 9.6 percent. In contrast, electricity prices increased 3.6 percent over the last 12 months and natural gas prices rose 15.7 percent.
