Change order for SGI

Dear Mr. Parsons:

Attached is change order No.4 for the WV Capitol Lighting PH-3 project. We recommend approval of the change order based on the following.

There is an existing fresh air duct that interferes with the locations of Vaults VB-115 and VB-116. It is thought this pipe/duct supplies air to a generator in the basement. This existing duct does not allow for the full depth light vault to be installed. The solution is to modify/cut the bottom of the vaults and add a clean gravel drainage field in front of the vaults. See attached drawing E1.1

There is an existing elevator shaft cover that is structurally unsound and unsafe for pedestrians on the east lawn. The existing cover and frame needs to be restored and rebuilt to be safe and function properly. See attached drawing E1.1

The grating over the large equipment ventilation vault on the north side of the east lawn visitor entrance was not noted to be replaced with new matching rod bar grating. After further review this grating should be replaced in the same manner as on the south side of the east lawn visitor entrance. Lights VB-113 and VB-114 shall be mounted inside the existing vault. See attached drawing E1.1.

Add four SC-1 poles along the building 9 parking loop. These poles will complete the replacement of all poles in this area. This will require new pole foundations, pole relocation, conduit, and wire to allow for this added work. See attached ES.2

Delete two SC-2 poles (P-30 and P-31) near the war memorial due to predicted interference with the existing memorial lighting. A credit is provided for deducting the labor to install 2 SC-2 foundations and poles. The Owner will retain the poles and luminaires so those costs are still included. See attached ES.2

Acubright approached SGI about modifying the RC post lights due to severe rusted metal. They are estimating there has been previous modifications over the past decades, and it likely caused severe rust damage. The cost is for additional labor required to restore these damage fixtures. See attached Acubright letter.

Added Work Change Order Request Rev 2

Specialty Groups, Inc., will supply all material, labor, and equipment to provide the following added work.

- 1. Vault VB-115 and VB-116 have interference with an existing fresh air duct pipe going to a generator in the basement. There will not be enough room or elevation to in the vault to install the designed drainage. We propose to cut off the bottom of the vaults and then add a clean gravel drainage field beside vaults. See attached drawing E1.1
- 2. The existing elevator shaft covers are structurally unsound and unsafe for pedestrians on the east lawn. We propose to restore and rebuild the existing elevator shaft lids and frames on east lawn to be safe and function. See attached drawing E1.1
- 3. The grating over the large equipment ventilation vault on the north side of the East lawn visitor entrance was left off the plans to be replaced with new matching rod bar grating. We propose to install VB-113 and VB-114 inside the vault and replace the grating to match the light vaults. See attached drawing See attached drawing E1.1
- 4. Four SC-1 poles were left off the plans along the building 9 parking loop. We propose to increase foundations, pole relocation, conduit, and wire to allow for this added work. See attached ES.2
- 5. SC-2 pole P-30 and P-31 near the war memorial are predicted to interfere with the existing lighting We are deducting the labor to install 2 SC-2 foundations and poles. The Owner will retain the poles and luminaires so that cost is still included. See attached ES.2
- 6. Acubright approached SGI about modifying the RC post lights due to severe rusted metal. They are estimating they have been modified in the past couple of decades, and it caused severe rust damage. See attached Acubright letter

We are requesting a contract extension of 30 days to allow for added labor time.




The water has rusted through both the original 1" black iron pipe as well as a 1/2" pipe that was run inside the original 1" pipe.


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


This open area is where the water is entering and causing issues.

Current setup appears to have a more modern globe mount slid over the main pipe. However this change left a large gap where water and debris can accumulate, and deteriorate the steel inner pipes.

Original setup would be something like this and would keep the interior of the fixture sealed from the elements.

We propose using a new globe with a custom fitter that would allow the globe to be mounted to the fixture as originally intended.

Damage Assessment:

Inspection of the lamppost fixtures after careful disassembly revealed severe rusting of the central and inner pipes due to water intrusion through a gap between the original bronze fixture and the retrofitted globe mount. Fixture #2 had completely rusted-through pipes, while Fixtures #3 and #4 had partial corrosion. The wiring also deteriorated beyond safe use, and the lighting components were inconsistent; two fixtures use a 165W Philips QL Induction system with an external generator, the other has a single E26 ceramic socket. The existing plastic globes have also noticeably yellowed with age. Finish variations were noted across the fixtures, ranging from dark antique bronze to slightly aged golden bronze with some areas of green patina. This indicates they may have been refinished at different times and potentially utilizing different methods.

Repair Recommendations:

- Globe Mount Modification: Remove retrofit mounts and create a new custom fitter to attach globes directly to the fixtures to prevent water intrusion and bird nesting.
- Custom Pipe Replacement: Remove deteriorated pipes, redrill and install custom galvanized pipes to
 prevent future rusting.
- Electrical Upgrade: Replace deteriorated wiring and convert QL Induction lighting to E26 or E39 sockets for easier maintenance and compatibility with LED lamppost bulbs.
- Globe Replacement: Use new 22" UV-resistant acrylic globes to prevent yellowing.
- Finish Restoration: Standardize refinishing; sample finishes will be provided for approval after we have evaluated the best options.

These repairs will enhance the safety, aesthetic, and longevity of the lampposts. The recommended repairs outside of the originally quoted work are outlined and priced below. Acu-Bright will need approval for this change order to add the recommended steps for restoration.



Request for approval to submit Change Order #4 to CPO 0211 GSD2500000004, the contract for the WV Capitol Exterior Lighting Project, an increase of \$56,760.00 and an extension of 30 days to the overall construction contract duration, to cover the following unforeseen scopes of work:

- -It was discovered in vaults VB-115 and VB-116, that there was interfering fresh air duct leading to the generator in the basement of Building 1. There will now not be enough room or elevation in the vaults to install the designed drainage. Proposed correction to cut off bottom of the vault and add a clean gravel drainage field beside the vault. (\$2,600.00)
- -While working in the lawn area it was discovered that the old, unused agricultural elevator shaft covers are structurally unsound and unsafe for pedestrian traffic. - 1. It was discovered in vaults VB-115 and VB-116, that there was interfering fresh air duct leading to the generator in the basement of Building 1. There will now not be enough room or elevation in the vaults to install the designed drainage. Proposed correction to cut off bottom of the vault and add a clean gravel drainage field beside the vault. (\$2,600.00)
- 2. While working in the area it was discovered that the elevator shaft covers are structurally unsound and unsafe for pedestrian traffic. This is a health and safety issue that needs addressed. SGI will restore and rebuild the elevator shaft lids and frames on the East Lawn. (\$6,000.00)
- 3. Design oversight left the grating off the ventilation vaults, this change addressed the issue by installing matching grating to the other vaults. (\$6,000.00)
- 4. Design oversight left four SC-1 poles off the plans along the Building 9 parking loop. This work adds the lighting as intended. (\$34,640.00)

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
