This letter is an official request to update a single line of the CMA DEPSOIL004 Inorganic and Organic Analysis Services contract.

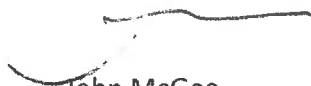
I'm requesting Line 128 Selenium High to state Method 200.8 instead of the submitted Method 200.7. We will honor the same pricing as the original \$10 that was quoted for 200.7. That is a \$2 loss per sample for Pace compared to the other 200.8 elements.

We listed our high and low methods but after the contract was awarded, it was determined DEP needed our mid-level detection limit. This request is so that samples can be submitted for the need, and DEP to not have to pay the \$38 for the lowest detection level we offer (3114). I have included the 200.8 limits below as well if needed.
