Dear Ms. Lothman,

Additional Owner Advisor services, as defined in the original scope of the above-referenced project are requested by the WVDEP.

During the 2025 Legislative Session, the WVDEP Design Build Pilot Program's budget was increased to \$75 million and the sunset date was extended to December 31, 2027. Due to these changes, the WVDEP will be increasing the number of projects included in the Pilot Program.

Due to the increased number of projects being conducted, the WVDEP will require the services of the Owner Advisor, as required in Procedural Rule 60CSR13, for procurement support, preconstruction & estimating, and technical and construction related support throughout the life of the pilot program.

The contract is being extended to December 31, 2027 to align with the new sunset date, and increased by \$2,400,000.00 to cover the expanded services required by adding new projects to the pilot program.

The total cumulative change in the project cost is in excess of 10% of the original contract sum.

The effective date of the change order is September 30, 2025.

Scope of Services for Design-Build Pilot Owner's Advisor Services Change Order 1

GENERAL

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP, Owner) entered into an agreement for Burns & McDonnell to provide Owner's Advisor (OA) for the Design-Build Pilot Program. Due to the extended budget and sunset date of the Pilot Program, a change order is needed for the OA to provide additional services to support additional pilot projects.

This Scope of Services details additional services to be provided by the OA. Owner's Advisor will continue to work collaboratively with WVDEP to support the Pilot Program; Owner's Advisor will continue to consult with and report to WVDEP, with WVDEP being responsible for final responses and decisions. Deliverables defined in this Scope of Services will be developed jointly by WVDEP and Owner's Advisor in a coordinated fashion based on information and data provided by WVDEP.

It is understood that the Owner's Advisor does not assume any responsibility for the accuracy and completeness of data and/or documents prepared by others, or for defects, omissions, departures from contractual requirements, or for means and methods of Design-Builders, or breach of performance of others working on the Design-Build Pilot Program. It is further understood that the Owner's Advisor will assist WVDEP in its efforts to implement the Design-Build Pilot Program, but that Owner's Advisor services are not intended to, and cannot, eliminate all risk or guarantee an efficient or best value program and/or project.

Additional Services. At the discretion of WVDEP and during the completion of the services defined in this Agreement, Owner's Advisor may be requested to provide additional Owner-authorized services related to the Pilot Program under an amendment to this Agreement and/or a separate agreement.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional Services to be provided by the Owner's Advisor under this Agreement are described below and organized under the following Task Series (Service Lanes):

TASK SERIES 100 – PROJECT/PROGRAM MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

TASK SERIES 200 - PROJECT CONTROLS

TASK SERIES 300 - DESIGN-BUILD PROCUREMENT SUPPORT

TASK SERIES 400 - STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

TASK SERIES 500 - PRECONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATING

TASK SERIES 600 - TECHNICAL AND CONSTRUCTION-RELATED SUPPORT

DESCRIPTION OF ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The following is a description of the additional work to be performed under this Scope of Services to assist WVDEP with its Design-Build Pilot Program.



TASK 100: PROJECT/PROGRAM MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

No additional Task 100 services are provided under this Scope of Services.

TASK 200: PROJECT CONTROLS

The original Basic Scope of Services included Task 200 services for four (4) design-build pilot projects. In consideration of the additional Pilot Program budget and extended sunset date, project controls services will be provided for all design-build pilot projects through the 2027 sunset date. Total efforts (time and materials) performed under this task will not exceed \$731,700, inclusive of additional effort (time and materials) budgeted as part of this change order of \$390,000

TASK 300: DESIGN-BUILD PROCUREMENT SUPPORT

The original Basic Scope of Services included Task 300 services for four (4) design-build pilot projects. In consideration of the additional budget and extended sunset date, WVDEP intends on procuring additional design-builders for additional design-build projects to be conducted under the Pilot Program. Total efforts (time and materials) performed under this task will not exceed \$529,300, inclusive of additional effort (time and materials) budgeted as part of this change order of \$200,000.

The following activities will be provided under this task:

- Design-Build contract observation
- Procurement document development
- Procurement observation and reporting
- Contract negotiations support
- External stakeholders support

The Owner's Advisor will provide additional design-build procurement support services as requested by WVDEP and mutually agreed upon as Additional Services.

TASK 400: STAKEHOLDER & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The original Basic Scope of Services included Task 400 services for four (4) design-build pilot projects. In consideration of the additional budget and extended sunset date, additional stakeholder and community engagement services may be required. Total efforts (time and materials) performed under this task will not exceed \$157,000, inclusive of additional effort (time and materials) budgeted as part of this change order of \$25,000.

TASK 500: PRECONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATING

The original Basic Scope of Services included Task 500 services for four (4) design-build pilot projects. In consideration of the additional budget and extended sunset date, WVDEP intends on procuring additional design-builders for additional design-build projects to be conducted under the Pilot Program. An additional \$145,000 has been budgeted for additional preconstruction and estimating support. Total efforts (time and materials) performed under this task will not exceed \$419,500.

The following activities will be provided under this task for additional projects on an as-needed basis to WVDEP:

Project validation of scope, cost, schedule, and risk



- Preconstruction and estimating support in procurement
 - Context and guidance related to information provided by Offerors in the procurement phase
- Preconstruction and estimating support after design-build contract execution, including reviews
 of price, schedule, and risk information, including Phase 2 price proposals, schedules, and
 contingencies

TASK 600: TECHNICAL AND CONSTRUCTION-RELATED SUPPORT

The original Basic Scope of Services included 65 hours for construction-related support. In consideration of the additional Pilot Program budget and sunset date, coupled with resourcing limitations within WVDEP, the Owner's Advisor has budgeted an additional \$1,819,000 (approximately 4,800 hours plus expenses) to provide construction-related support to WVDEP, including the following items:

- Attend periodic construction coordination meetings with Design-Build teams and provide DEP with summary and action items. Help track DEP action items for agency action.
- Provide general assistance to DEP project managers on the design-build process to support them as they interact and manage their respective Design-Builders. This includes support to DEP's project managers with general coordination between DEP, design-builder, third-party stakeholders, etc.
- Review/track submittals, RFIs, and design clarifications for consistency with project goals and Design-Builder Phase 2 Price Proposal
- Provide regular site visits to observe progress, flag potential issues early
- Monitor construction schedules and provide DEP with risk-based updates and summary of any additional potential schedule impacts
- Review contractor's pay application packages for completeness for DEP approval process
- Track and review field changes, contractor change order requests and the general appropriateness of change orders, including potential responses to a change order for DEP to provide the Design-Builder.
- Help develop and/or monitor field issues/risk log through resolution of identified risks
- Support DEP with compliance tracking for permits, environmental requirements, and commitments
- Assist DEP in evaluating claims or disputes and present and document Owner's rationale or options
- Provide contractor knowledge sharing/coaching during the project delivery phase. Activities may include, but would not be limited to the following:
 - General Phase 2 phase quality best practices
 - Project Controls, including risk management best practices
 - Knowledge sharing of DBIA best practices
- Support Substantial and Final Completion, including punch list creation and tracking, training and commissioning review and documentation, final O&M manual reviews, etc.
- Support reviewing Design-Builder as-builts for accuracy and completeness for DEP acceptance.



OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

Owner will furnish the following items, as required by the Scope of Services, and not at the expense of the Owner's Advisor:

- a. Provide to Owner's Advisor available information pertinent to performance of the defined Basic Scope of Services, including project information, previous reports, drawings, specifications, and any other data relative thereto.
- b. Provide the services of at least one WVDEP employee who has the right of entry to and knowledge of a project area. Site visits will be required on multiple occasions over the course of the Project.
- c. Provide hosting services and access to the Owner's document management system (Google Drive) throughout the life of the Pilot Program.
- d. Secure "exploratory right of entry" from applicable property owners.
- e. All permitting and permitting oversight for permits required for the pilot program, regardless of if WVDEP or Design-Builder have responsibility.
- f. Public advertisement of Pilot Program projects.
- g. Provide, as may be required:
 - a. Accounting and financial advisory, independent and insurance counseling services;
 - b. Such legal services as WVDEP may require or Owner's Advisor may reasonably request regarding legal issues pertaining to the Pilot Program, including any that may be raised by professional service providers or construction contractors.

ASSUMPTIONS

- a. Owner's Advisor services are assumed to end December 31, 2027 consistent with the WVDEP Design-Build Pilot Program.
- b. Owner's Advisor will provide no support related to permitting, real estate, or right of entry.
- c. Owner's Advisor rates for services provided in 2025 and 2026 under Change Order 1 will be as previously approved by Owner.
- d. Pilot projects may be delivered using Fixed-Price or Progressive Design-Build Delivery Methods.
- e. Design-Builders will be responsible for individual pilot project means and methods.


