Re: Request for Bid Rejection- CRFQ MIS25*02 Adobe Products or Equal

My office recently received a copy of the letter from your team requesting that the bid you submitted for CRFQ MIS25*02 be rejected, even though the contract was already signed and awarded.

Per WV CSR 148-1-6.3.6 "the Director may reject a bid a vendor declares to be erroneous after the bid opening, but otherwise appears to be responsive, if, all of the following conditions exist: (1) an error was made; (2) The error materially affected the bid; (3) Rejection of the bid would not cause a hardship on the State spending unit involved, other than losing an opportunity to receive commodities, services or printing at a reduced cost; and (4) Enforcement of the part of the bid in error would be unconscionable" (emphasis added). This rule specifically applies to the rejection of a bid after opening, not cancellation of a contract which is already in existence. For that reason, bid rejection would not be appropriate at this stage. After all the bids were received, evaluated, and your team was notified that you would be awarded the contract, there was an opportunity at that time for you to request a bid rejection prior to finalization of a contract award.

That being said, if the above findings are compelling, that could present a reasonable basis to agree to contract cancellation. Your letter walks through each of the four requirements stated above in turn, and I will respond to those accordingly.

1. "During our bid preparation, we mistakenly applied Level 6 Adobe pricing under the Large Government Agreement (LGA) instead of the required Level 4 pricing without LGA, as a result, our submitted bid included significantly lower pricing. approximately \$61,000 in total for 3 years - than what was intended and appropriate under the correct terms."

Having reviewed the file including the bid you submitted along with the bids of your competitors, in multiple places you identify that the bid pricing you provide is for "User Level 4 100+," this is clear on your pricing page for each line item. The evidence from your bid suggests that you knowingly bid a specific price for a Level 4 User and does not suggest an error as you describe. It is also worth noting here that while this contract is awarded with renewals, renewals are optional and require agreement by both parties to continue for the remaining years.

2. "The error caused our bid to include incorrect pricing based on an LGA model the agency did not request. This made our offer non-compliant and misaligned with the State's requirements, affecting the fairness of the evaluation and not reflecting the value we intended to offer."

As mentioned above, each line item specification and model number provides detail that the pricing is related to a "User Level 4." Further, a look at other bids provided shows that your price points are very similar to the next two lowest bidders after you. This suggests that in a competitive market, your cost is comparable and reasonable, it certainly does not suggest that your cost was unfairly low.

3. "We fully recognize the importance of continuity in service delivery and procurement efficiency for the State. In this instance, rejection of our bid would not result in any operational disruption, delay, or inability for the State to procure the required Adobe licenses or services in a timely manner. Other vendors can fulfill the request as specified. Therefore, rejection would not cause hardship but would maintain the integrity of the procurement process."

Because this contract has already been awarded to your company, and we cannot simply "reject" your bid as it is an awarded contract, acceptance of your cancellation request likely would cause hardship to the State, as it would require us to cancel an existing contract, then reenter the contract negotiation process with the next vendors in line. This could cause significant delays in acquiring the services our agency needs, and which your team has already agreed to provide for a set price in the contract documents.

4. "Enforcing our bid would result in a financial loss for Saitech Inc. Proceeding under these conditions would be commercially unreasonable and go against both the agency's intent and our good faith efforts."

The agency entered into a signed contract with your company on the good faith understanding that you offered a fixed, firm price for the products and services they need. This contract was reviewed and evaluated both by the agency and by your team before the agreement was finalized and issued. At this stage, it seems

as though the integrity of the procurement process would be harmed by failing to require your company to follow through on the good faith promise to perform at the price you provided in your public bid. That in conjunction with the fact that your bid price is comparable to the other resellers that bid against you, suggests that it would not be unreasonable and certainly not unconscionable to request you to hold the price bid.

The State has no interest in forcing a company to provide services at a loss. If you provide additional evidence to support a cancellation of the contract based upon your inability to provide the services at the cost you bid, we can discuss that. However, please note that per WV CSR 148-1-5.4.1 circumstances such as withdrawing a bid after opening or failure to fulfill contractual obligations may be grounds for short-term suspension from the bidding process.

I would be glad to discuss this situation with you in more detail at any time to see if we can come to a mutually agreeable resolution. Saitech Inc. was awarded Contract CMA MIS2600000006 (with an effective start date of August 1, 2025) based on a responsive bid submitted on June 2, 2025 for solicitation CRFO 0511 MIS2500000002. Other competing vendors were disqualified for noncompliance with mandatory bid requirements and ultimately Saitech was awarded the contract.

Following contract execution, Saitech requested a price modification, alleging the agency was ineligible for Level 6 pricing and should be charged Level 4 rates, citing a \$20,000 annual discrepancy and associated burden. The agency rejects this claim, noting Saitech did not contest terms nor pricing prior to the award and asserts the pricing tiers are internal to Saitech's manufacturer relationship and immaterial to the awarded contract. Also, the agency notes that renewal years are optional and the vendor may elect not to renew the contract at the end of the first contract year.

The solicitation (Section 4.1.1.1 and Addendum 1, dated May 20, 2025) specified the use of Adobe's VIP program and excluded the LGA program, of which the terms would violate State requirements for firm and fixed pricing as it allows for a "true up" pricing mechanism. Postaward, Saitech sought to alter pricing and introduce LGA terms, both actions contradicting the solicitation and executed agreement. These requests were denied, and the vendor has requested to fully cancel the contract.



They agency does not feel the vendor meets the four necessary conditions of the West Virginia Code of State Rules 148 CSR 1-5.2.G in order to have their bid rejected. The vendor did not object to or question their bid until after the contract was awarded.

Also, Saitech's proposed cancellation places the agency at risk, with critical Adobe licenses set to expire on August 11, 2025, and additional expirations are imminent. The agency lacks sufficient time to resolicit a contract prior to the current license expiration dates.

As such, the agency recommends the Purchasing Division:

- Deny Saitech's cancellation request and enforce the contract in order for the agency to
 preserve essential licensing an order needs to be placed this week to avoid license
 expiration.
- If the vendor will not agree to abide by the contract, the agency requests the vendor be suspended from the bidding process under WV Code §5A-3-32 for material misrepresentation and noncompliance.

We hope this letter finds you well. Saitech Inc. sincerely appreciates the opportunity to participate in the competitive bidding process with the State of West Virginia and values the longstanding partnership we share.

After careful review and internal assessment, we have identified an error in our submitted bid for the above-referenced solicitation. In accordance with the West Virginia Code of State Rules 148 CSR 1-5.2. G, we hereby submit this formal written request for rejection of our bid. We respectfully provide the following documented evidence demonstrating that all four conditions required for bid rejection have been met:

1. An error was made:

During our bid preparation, we mistakenly applied Level 6 Adobe pricing under the Large Government Agreement (LGA) instead of the required Level 4 pricing without LGA. This error was not identified until after the award notice was published. As a result, our submitted bid included significantly lower pricing, approximately \$61,000 in total for 3 years—than what was intended and appropriate under the correct terms.

2. The error materially affected the bid:

The error caused our bid to include incorrect pricing based on an LGA model the agency did not request. This made our offer non-compliant and misaligned with the



State's requirements, affecting the fairness of the evaluation and not reflecting the value we intended to offer.

- 3. Rejection of the bid would not cause hardship on the State spending unit: We fully recognize the importance of continuity in service delivery and procurement efficiency for the State. In this instance, rejection of our bid would not result in any operational disruption, delay, or inability for the State to procure the required Adobe licenses or services in a timely manner. Other vendors can fulfill the request as specified. Therefore, rejection would not cause hardship but would maintain the integrity of the procurement process.
- 4. Enforcement of the part of the bid in error would be unconscionable:

They agency does not feel the vendor meets the four necessary conditions of the West Virginia Code of State Rules 148 CSR 1-5.2.G in order to have their bid rejected. The vendor did not object to or question their bid until after the contract was awarded.

1. An error was made:


