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I) GENERAL

A) DESCRIPTION

- 1) The West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) is soliciting bids for a manufactured, as-built metal building
- 2) The successful bidder shall provide all labor, material, and as built drawings required to erect this building at the Gus R. Douglass Agricultural Center at Guthrie (GRDACAG). The GRDACAG facility is located at 4720 Brenda Lane, Charleston, WV 25312.
- 3) The job must be completed by May 31, 2007.

B) SUBMITTALS

- 1) Installation Drawings
 - (a) Submit completed installation drawings and installation details by the manufacturer to the owner for review. Do not proceed with manufacture prior to review and owner's approval of installation drawings. Do not use drawings prepared by the owner for installation drawings.
 - (b) Installation drawings shall show methods of installation, footer design, elevations and plans of roof and wall panels, sections and details, specified loads, flashings, roof curbs, vents, sealants, interfaces with all materials not supplied by the metal roofing system manufacturer, and proposed identification of component parts and their finishes.
- 2) Sample of the manufacturer's warranty
- 3) Submit a letter of certification from the manufacturer that certifies the building contractor is authorized to install the manufacturer's building system.
- 4) Upon completion of the installed work, submit copies of the manufacturer's final inspection to the specified, prior to the issuance of the manufacturer's warranty.

C) PRODUCT DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- 1) Deliver materials to the job site in the manufacturer's original, unopened containers or wrappings with the manufacturer's name, brand name, and installation instructions intact and legible. Deliver in sufficient quantity to permit work to continue without interruption.
- 2) Comply with the manufacturer's written instructions for proper material storage
- 3) Any materials which are found to be damaged shall be removed and replaced at the applicator's expense.
- 4) Store all materials and accessories above ground on well-supported platforms Store under waterproof covering. Provide proper ventilation of metal roofing system to prevent condensation build up between each panel or trim/flashing component

D) USE OF THE PREMISES

1) Before beginning work the contractor must secure approval from the building owner's representative for the following:

(a) Areas permitted for parking

- (b) Access to the site; this will generally be Monday thru Friday, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. No holiday or weekend work permitted without prior approval by the WVDA contact.
- (c) Areas permitted for storage of materials and debris.

E) EXISTING CONDITIONS

1) If discrepancies are discovered between the existing conditions and those noted on the drawings, immediately notify the owner's representative by phone and solicit the manufacturer's approval prior to commencing with the work.

F) TEMPORARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS

1) Temporary Utilities:

(a) On-site power for construction purposes will be made available.

(b) Potable water is not available at the site. Potable water is within one-half mile if needed and can be provided by the owner from a source designated by the owner.

(c) Temporary sanitary facilities: on-site sanitary facilities will not be available. The building contractor will be responsible for the provision and maintenance of portable toilets or their equal.

(d) Security: obey the owner's requirements for personnel identification, inspection, and other security measures.

G) JOB SITE PROTECTION

- 1) The building contractor shall adequately protect the building, paved areas, service drives, lawn, shrubs, trees, etc. from damage while performing the required work. The contractor shall repair or be responsible for costs to repair all property damaged during the building process.
- 2) During the building contractor's performance of the work, the property owner will require access to the adjacent building.
- 3) The building contractor shall remove all debris from the job site in a timely and legally acceptable manner so as not to detract from the aesthetics or the functions of the building.

H) WORKMANSHIP

- 1) All work shall be of the highest quality and in strict accordance with the manufacturer's published specifications and to the building owner's satisfaction.
- 2) There shall be a supervisor on the job site at all times while work is in progress.

I) CLEAN UP

- 1) Perform daily clean-up to collect all wrappings, empty containers, paper, and other debris from the project site.
- 2) Upon completion, all debris must be disposed of in a legally acceptable manner.

J) QUALITY ASSURANCE

- 1) AISC-MB certified manufacturers of metal buildings are the only acceptable suppliers.
- 2) This project shall meet or exceed the 2000 International Building Code for Kanawha County WV.
- 3) All bidders must be a licensed vendor with the State of West Virginia
- 4) The Contractor and/or Subcontractors shall pay the higher of the U.S. Department of Labor minimum wage or rates as established for the respective WV County pursuant to WV Code 21-5-1, ET, SEQ.
- 5) The manufacturer must have a minimum of ten years experience in the manufacturing of metal buildings.
- 6) Unless otherwise noted in this specification, the building contractor must strictly comply with the manufacturer's current specifications and details.
- 7) The building contractor must be trained by the manufacturer in compliance with drawings as approved by the manufacturer. The building contractor shall be thoroughly experienced and upon request be able to provide evidence of having at least five (5) years successful experience erecting metal buildings and having erected at least one (1) building of equal or greater size within one year.
- 8) Provide adequate number of experienced workmen regularly engaged in this type of work who are skilled in the application techniques of the materials specified. Provide at least one thoroughly trained and experienced superintendent on the job at all times work is in progress.
- 9) Upon completion of the installation, the applicator shall arrange for an inspection to be made by a non-sales technical representative of the manufacturer in order to determine whether or not corrective work will be required before the warranty will be issued. Notify the building owner seventy-two (72) hours prior to the manufacturer's final inspection.

K) JOB CONDITIONS, CAUTIONS AND WARNINGS

1) No underground utilities are known to exist within the building foot print.

2) Access to the site is through a private land owner's right of way. This will require the contractor to keep gates closed providing access to the building site.

II) SCOPE OF WORK

A) SITE PREPARATION

- 1) Before work begins the final grade preparation will be the responsibility of WVDA.
- 2) The successful vendor shall be responsible for excavation of the column footings and the perimeter grade beams.

B) CONCRETE

Column footings shall extend to a depth of no less than twenty-four inches (24) to set below any fill material.

C) METAL BUILDING

Three options, of which one will be chosen, shall be submitted for the manufacturer of an as-built metal building at the GRDACAG facility. See attached drawings.

- 1) Option A
 - (a) Size Building shall be 70-feet end wall x 65-feet side wall x 14-feet in height. Height must allow 12-foot clearance for vehicle access through overhead doors.
 - (b) Garage doors Install three (3) operational, non-insulated, sectional, overhead, commercial, garage doors with locks. Doors shall be equipped with electronic opener. Electric hookup will be provided by others. I wo (2) overhead doors at least 22-feet wide x 12-feet high and one (1) overhead door at least 12-feet wide x 12-feet high.
 - (c) Entrance doors Install two (2) steel entrance doors one on each side wall, 36-inch wide, 6-foot 8-inch-high. Doors shall be supplied with entrance locksets that are keyed alike. Doors shall be primed and finished.

2) Option B

- (a) Size Building shall be 70-feet end wall x 50-feet side wall x 14-feet in height. Height must allow 12-foot clearance for vehicle access through overhead doors.
- (b) Garage doors Install two (2) operational, non-insulated, sectional, overhead, and commercial, garage doors with locks. Doors shall be equipped with electronic opener. Electric hookup will be provide by others. Two (2) overhead doors at least 22-feet wide x 12-feet high.
- (c) Entrance doors Install two (2) steel entrance doors one on each side wall, 36-inch wide, 6-foot 8-inch high. Doors shall be supplied with entrance locksets that are keyed alike. Doors shall be primed and finished.

3) Option C

- (a) Size Building shall be 40-feet end wall x 100-feet side wall x 14-feet height. Height must allow 12-foot clearance for vehicle access through overhead doors.
- (b) Garage doors Install four (4) operational, non-insulated, sectional, overhead, commercial, garage doors with locks. Doors shall be equipped with electronic opener. Electric hookup will be provide by others. Four (4) overhead doors at least 22-feet wide x 12-feet high.
- (c) Entrance doors Install two (2) steel entrance doors one on each side wall, 36-inch wide, 6-foot 8-inch high. Doors shall be supplied with entrance locksets that are keyed alike. Doors shall be primed and finished.


4) All three option shall include:


- (a) Clear span structure with 4:12 roof pitch; 30-pound ground snow load; 90-mile per hour wind load; and, 5-pound roof collateral load.
- (b) Building structures shall consist of clear-span steel frames. Steel frames, wall girts, roof purlins, bracing, and other secondary structural components shall be shop painted with red-oxide primer.
- (c) Ridge vents shall cover no less than 50% of the ridge line.
- (d) Eave light panels for each bay on back side walls.
- (e) Insulated walls and roof with 3-inch R-11 vinyl faced fiberglass insulation
- (f) No windows
- (g) Roof and wall panels shall be bare Galvalume 26-gauge and warranted for no less than 20 years.
- (h) No overhang on end wall.
- (i) Open bays
- (j) Minimal side wall overhang. Both side walls shall have 6-inch (6) gutters with downspouts located at the 4 corners.
- (k) Downspout hooks to in-ground waste water which will be installed by others.

D) TIME FRAME

- 1) Job must be completed prior to May 31, 2007.
- 2) Any requests for extension due to unforeseen circumstances must be completed in writing and submitted to the WVDA contact person.

NOTE - Drawings, preliminary specifications and documentation provided by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture are preliminary and for bid purposes only No structural analysis has been provided in these preliminary specifications.

AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states:

No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

'Debt" means any assessment, premium penalty fine tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon

Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount

EXCEPTION:

The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement

LICENSING:

The vendor must be licensed in accordance with any and all state requirements to do business with the state of West Virginia

CONFIDENTIALITY:

The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
