Would Summit be liable for these damages if the late delivery were due to Bell Helicopter and not the completion center? If that is the case, then the completion centers would be forced to factor that in the bid, inflating the final cost to the state of WV to cover the loss incurred by these Damages If you could let us know how this will occur it would greatly help in submitting a competitive bid for this project.
