GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFF)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this contract is automatically null and void, and is terminated without further order.

West Virginia Motorcycle Safety Program — The Ride is Intoxicating Enough — Billboards 2006

West Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles is requesting quotes for billboards to promote the 2006 Motorcycle Safety Awareness Campaign.

The quote shall include the production and posting of 31 Poster Panels (billboards) which shall be 12' x 25' in size. The quote will also include the production and posting of 4 vinyl Bulletin Boards (billboards) which shall be 14' x 48' in size.

The artwork for the poster panels and bulletin boards will be provided by the Division of Motor Vehicles, Motorcycle Safety Program, with final approval being that of the Motorcycle Safety Program Coordinator.

The vendor shall maintain and store the vinyl until which time the vendor will re-display According to the locations and dates listed below.

Locations and Display Dates

Northern Communities:

Two poster panels in the Wheeling/Moundsville area on State Route 2 north or south of both cities beginning October 25, 2006, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by March 25, 2007, for an additional thirty days. Also in the Wheeling area, a bulletin board which should be located and posted along Interstate 1-70, the beginning date being October 25, 2006, for an additional thirty days.

Two poster panels in the Parkersburg area on State Route 68 and/or State Route 2. The panels are to be posted by **October 25**, **2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **March 25**, **2007**, for an additional thirty days.

Three poster boards in the Morgantown area on State Route 7 and/or U.S. Routes 19, 119. The panels are to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **March 25, 2007**, for an additional thirty days.

Two poster panels in the Clarksburg/Fairmont area on U.S. Routes 19, 19S and/or U.S. Route 50. The panels are to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **March 25, 2007**, for an additional thirty days.

One poster panel in the Buckhannon/Elkins area on U.S Routes 250, 219, 33 and/or State Route 55. The panel is to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **March 25, 2007**, for an additional thirty days. Two poster panels in the Romney Moorefield area on U.S. Route 50 and/or U>S. Route 220. The panels are to be posted by March 25, 20076, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by May 25, 2007, for an additional thirty days.

Southern Communities:

Two poster panels in the Huntington/Milton area on State Route 10 and/or (3.5. Route 60 or 52. The panels are to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **April 15, 2007**, for an additional thirty days.

Two poster panels in the Hamlin/Wayne/Lavallette area on State Routes 3, 37, 10 and/or State Route 152. The panels are to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **April 15, 2007**, for an additional thirty days.

Two poster panes in the Logan/Gilbert/Welch area on State Route 10 and/or U.S. Route 52. The panels are to be posted by March 25, 2007, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by May 25, 2007, for an additional thirty days.

Two poster panels in the Danville/Madison/Chesapeake area on State Routes 85, 17 and/or State Route 94. The panels are to be posted by **October 25, 2006**, to run for thirty consecutive days and reposted by **April 15, 2007**, for an additional thirty days.
