

These projects have included small additions to existing office buildings; schematic design and programming of the

174,000 square-foot WV Department of Environmental Protection office building; 55,000 square-foot chain grocery stores in 3 states; 38 new or renovated drug stores for a national chain; a 74,000 square-foot academic sports and recreation center for West Liberty State College, additions and renovations to courthouses and courthouse annexes in

A project of interest to this committee is the Eastern West Virginia Regional Airport Terminal building, which includes a restaurant and bar with a fully equipped kitchen. Mr. Withrow also is providing architectural design, code research, and production management for elevator renovations to several state buildings including the Capitol, the Tax and Revenue Offices (Building 22), and the warehouse and office facilities at Building 20, Building 7, and Holly Grove, among others, for the State's elevator consultant. He has received recognition for project quality and productivity and is a member of the Curriculum Advisory Board for the Community and Technical College at West Virginia University Institute of Technology at Montgomery.

His portfolio includes school facilities, office buildings, county courthouses, complex research and

He will also assist in the construction administration phases of your project. Mr. Warnock has



provided detailed computer renderings, 3-D imagery and, and 3-D animation, which have been used in grant applications and fund raising efforts for county community centers, a non-profit men's shelters, and community awareness campaigns. A project of interest is the recently completed Senior Center for the City of Vienna, which includes a commercial kitchen. all" rest stops for the West Virginia Division of Highways.




