1.0 General Contract Information

The scope of work for this project is to remove an existing vehicular exhaust removal system and provide and install a new updated vehicular exhaust removal system in the West Virginia Army National Guard's FMS #9 Shop in Moundsville West Virginia. Contractor to provide an exhaust removal system that meets or exceeds any and all state and federal codes. The exhaust removal system shall be in compliance with all OSHA requirements.

Contractor shall provide:

- a) Demolition and disposal of old exhaust system off site at contractor's expense.
- b) Provide all materials and labor to provide a complete project.
- c) Contractor to provide a two (2) drops in both work bays. A total of Four (4) drops. All four (4) vehicular Exhaust Removal system drops must have the capability of removing idle speed exhaust simultaneously and continually. Furthermore two (2) of the drops (see attached layout drawing below) must be able to remove exhaust at hydraulic load testing RPMs.

(NOTE: CONTRACTOR HAS THE RIGHT TO HAVE ALL 4 DROPS OPERATE AT THE HYDRAULIC LOAD TESTING RPMS IF HE SO CHOOSES, BECAUSE OF COST OR OTHER CONSTRAINTS.)

- d) After the completion of the installation of the new vehicular exhaust removal system the contractor is responsible for having the new vehicular exhaust removal system tested for operation and OSHA compliance by a replicable source. These testing procedures are to be at the contractors expense. The contractor is responsible for forwarding these results to the West Virginia Army National Guard, Division of Engineering. These results should be sent to Attention Major Michael Beckner, the Facilities Management Specialist.
- e) Existing vehicular exhaust removal system is to be removed and disposed of in an environmentally acceptable manner, off site at contractor's expense.

1.1 Design Restraints

The Exhaust removal system needs to have hose adaptors that allow for 3 inch through 5 inch exhausts stacks, both vertical top stack and horizontal undercarriage stacks. The fan size for the new vehicular exhaust removal system shall be designed around the Military's Heavy Expanded Mobility Tactical Truck (HEMTT).

HEMTT ENGINE SPECIFICATIONS are as follows:

Manufacture: Detroit Diesel Allison

Type: 736 cubic inch, 8 cylinder, 2-stroke, V-type Diesel

Rating: 450 horsepower, @ 2100 rpm

1.2 COORDINATION OF TRADES

Ductwork offsets, fittings, and any other accessories required shall be furnished to provide a complete exhaust system installation.

1.3 DELIVERY AND STORAGE

All equipment delivered and placed in storage shall be housed in a manner to preclude any damage from the weather, humidity and temperature variations, dirt and dust, or other contaminants. Additionally, all ductwork, flexible connections and pipes shall either be capped or plugged until installed.

1.4 FIELD MEASUREMENTS

The Contractor shall become familiar with all details of the work, verify all dimensions in the field, and shall advise the project manager of any discrepancy before performing the work. Measurements can be obtained at the mandatory pre-bid meeting.

1.5 EXHAUST HOSE SYSTEM

Exhaust Hose System shall be rated to with stand continuous run. Exhaust hoses shall be have enough length as to accommodate both top stacks and under carriage stacks.

1.6 Tailpipe Adapters

Adapters shall be of the tapered-cone type with spring clips or other suitable devices for exhaust pipe attachment. The adapter shall fit 3 inch through 5 inch nominal diameter exhaust pipe.

1.7 Exhaust Hose Suspension System

The exhaust hose suspension system shall be reel type system so that can be lowered to the operating level, when required. The suspension system shall be furnished complete and operational. An electric operated reel type system is not required, a mechanical reel is acceptable.

1.8 Electrical Work


Contractor shall make all electrical connections on the new vehicular exhaust removal system to provide a working finished product. This includes but not limited to, wiring,

conduit, switches, and junction boxes. Electric equipment, including wiring and motor efficiencies, shall be according to all state and federal laws and codes.

1.9 Building Surface Penetrations

Sleeves or framed openings shall be utilized where duct penetrates building surfaces. Penetrations shall be sealed. Closure collars shall be installed around the duct on both sides of the penetrated surface. Collars shall fit tight against the building surfaces and snugly around the duct.



Housing shall be provided with drilled inlet and discharge flanges. Welds on fan housing shall be preformed by factory certified personnel who have met the ASME Section IX. Housing shall be constructed with four flat sides to allow discharge to vertical or horizontal positions with disassembly of fan. Fan motor shall be UL listed and manufactured by a readily nationally recognized motor manufacture. Motor shall be totally sealed and lubricated, totally enclosed fan cooled non-ventilated type with NEMA frame from 56-145T designed for application where standard and intermittent starts on average of ten to twenty times per day.

Motor bearings shall be heavy duty anti-friction, self aligning ball and or roller bearings with positive shaft locking.
