Questions and Answers

Q1. Where does the highwall elimination end?

A1. Right there, this side of that flag. Highwall elimination is to be blended in with the road bank.

Q2. What do we do with the trees?

A2. You can just work those right back in and put them in the backfill as long as you walk them in with a dozer and put them in an area where they will not hurt the stability.

Q3. The material left behind that you don't need, does it need to be re-graded also?

A3. Yes, any material that is disturbed needs to be re-graded to sheet flow.

Q4. Can you go below the road?

A4. Yes, you can go below the road if you want to. It's all within the bonded area.

Q5. Does the road have to stay in when we're finished?

A5. When you're finished you need to leave a passable road, not only here but at the other highwall elimination out there.

Q6. If you tram in equipment and tram out on the access road is that going to be a problem as long as you don't work the road?

A6. No it shouldn't be a problem but we're going to have you cut the water off the access road because it's our access road for inspection. All disturbance shall be revegetated.

Q7. On the acreage you've got for the seeding, does that include the access road going up?

A7. Yes it does.

Q8. On the blasting, do you have to have a certified surface blaster on this project?

A8. You have to comply with all the blasting regulations.

Q9. On an active surface mine you have to be a certified blaster, does that apply here?

A9. You have to comply with the WVDEP blasting regulations.

Q10. How many linear feet is this highwall? (Rocky Point)

A10. The total up here is approximately five hundred linear feet, we don't have it broken down by area.

Q11. At the top of the highwall, is there a limit on the top on how far back you can go to get your slope?

A11. We don't want you disturbing anymore area than it takes to get a two horizontal to one vertical slope.

Q12. Is your soil on site?

A12. Yes, and if it's not available you are required by the specifications to make it.

Q13. Should you not have to go off-site for topsoil?

A13. The specifications say that you will make it from material on-site.

Q14. If we use the option of drilling and shooting we don't have to sheet flow this do we?

A14. No, if you don't disturb out in front of the 2,000 linear feet highwall elimination we are not going to do anything to it.

Q15. Do we have to contact anyone to come back in and will the gates be locked?

A15. No, we have not found these gates locked since we have been coming in here. You are free to come in as often as you want and bring whoever you want to be able to give us a bid.

Q16. Are we going to sheet flow what's in front of the 2,000 linear feet highwall if we don't disturb it?

A16. You can't dig a hole in front to generate material and leave a low area, however if you fill down to the existing area in front of the highwall you don't have to do anymore work if you don't disturb it. You can't leave a hole between the highwall and the out slope.

Q17. Can we lock the gates if we are the successful bidder?

A17. We don't have a problem with that, but it needs to be coordinated with the property owner and it will be the successful bidder's responsibility to do that.

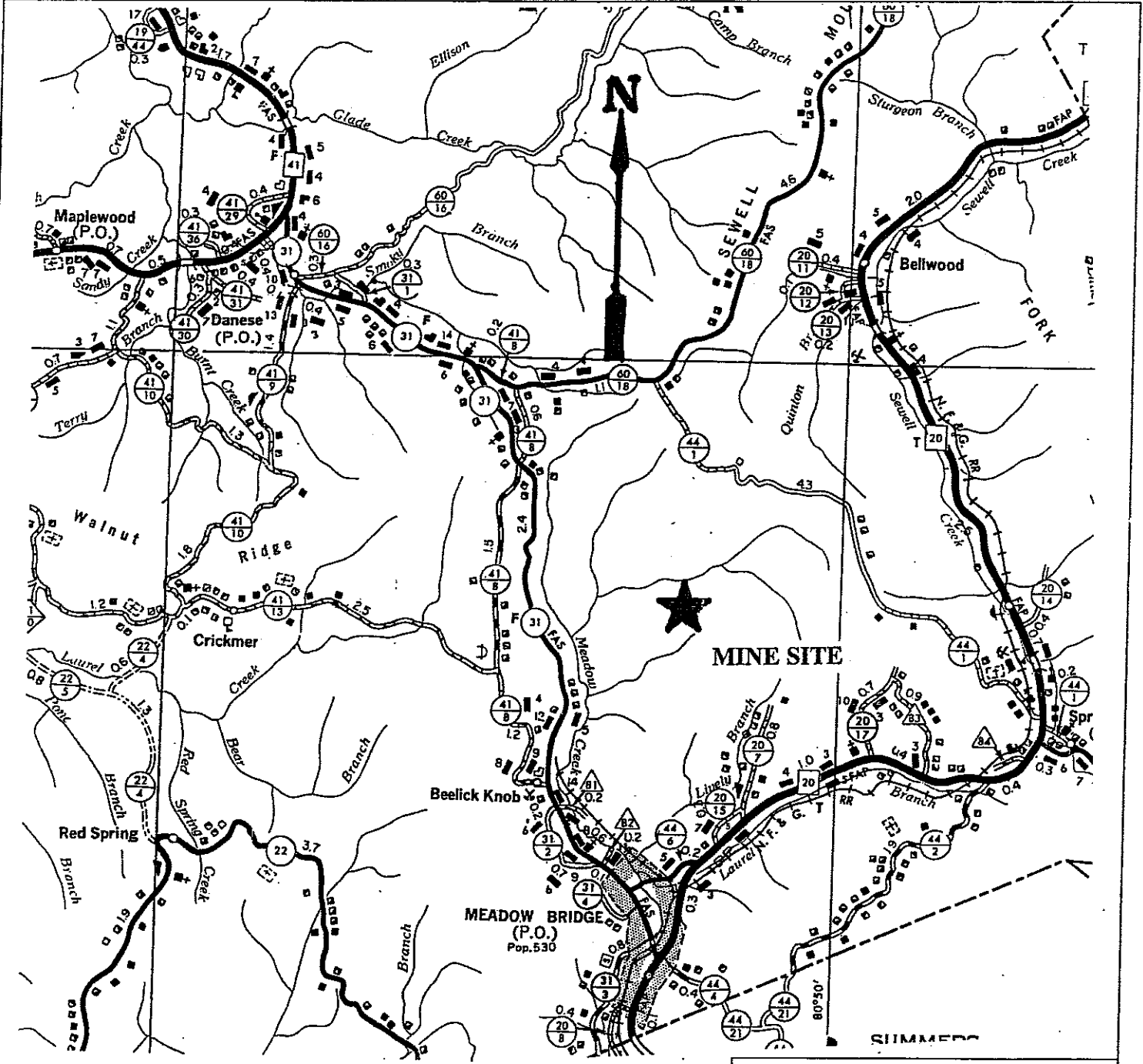

SCOPE OF WORK

The successful bidder shall provide appropriate equipment, materials, labor and any technical services needed for the successful reclamation of Raleigh Commercial Development Corporation, Permit 187-74, and any disturbance associated with such operation. The General Performance Standards (GPS) shall apply to all items in Scope of Work.

Work necessary on this site will include the following items, but is not limited to these:

1. Upon mobilization to the site, which will be directed in a written Notice to Proceed, the access roads shall be developed in accordance with bid item # 3.0. If fuel and lubricants are to be stored on site, bid item # 2.0 shall be in place before fuel is delivered. Project sign shall be constructed and erected in accordance with attached specifications. The sign shall be maintained during the construction activities and through the life of the warranty period. Sign cost is a No Bid Item and included with mobilization cost. No work shall be authorized or allowed at site until sign is constructed and erected on site and approved by DEP.
2. Storm water management in the form as described in bid item # 8.0 shall be installed.

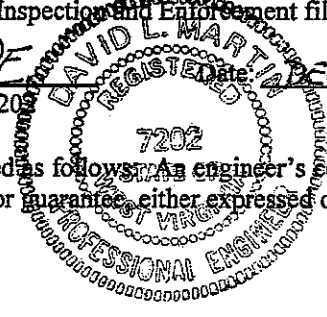

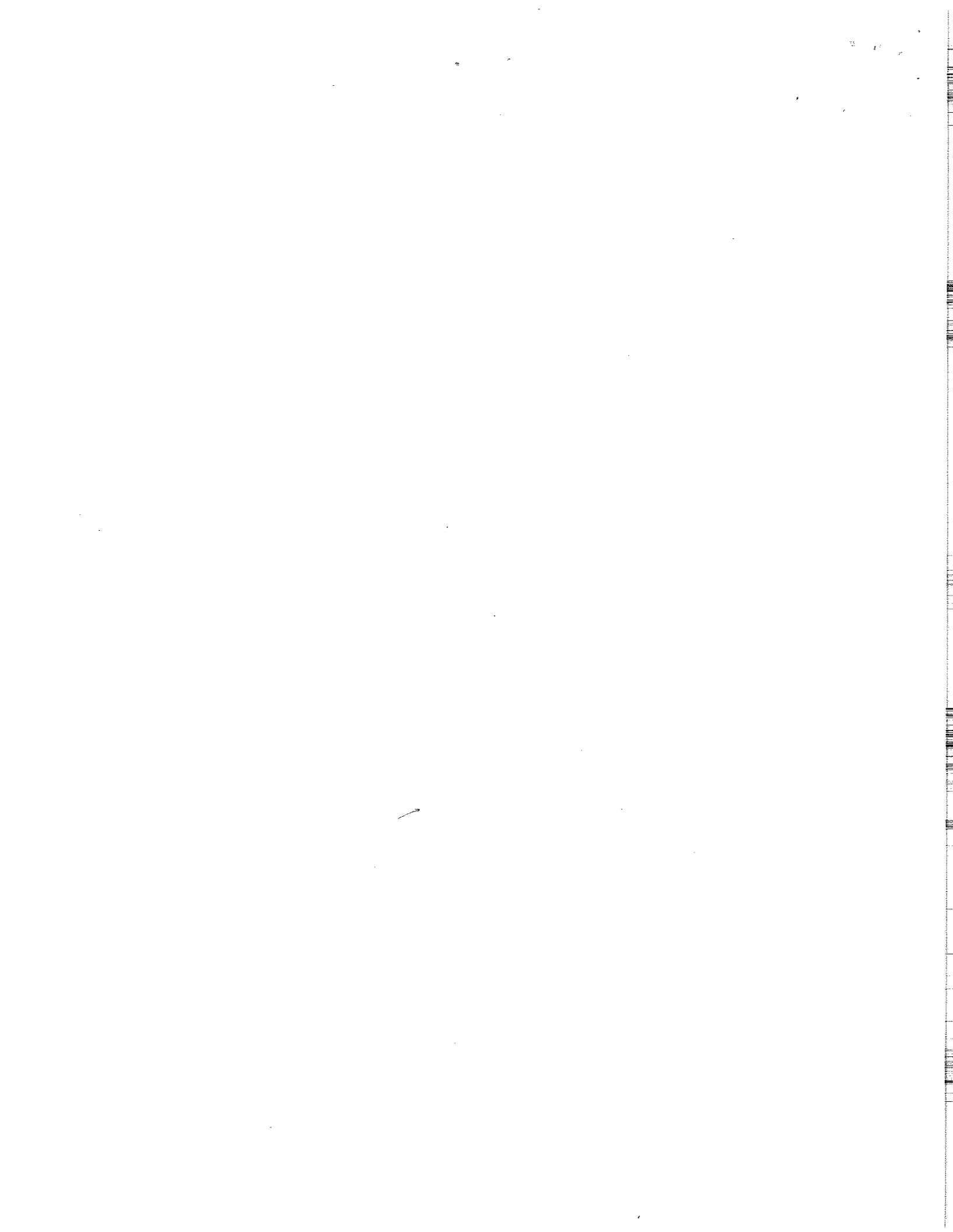

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

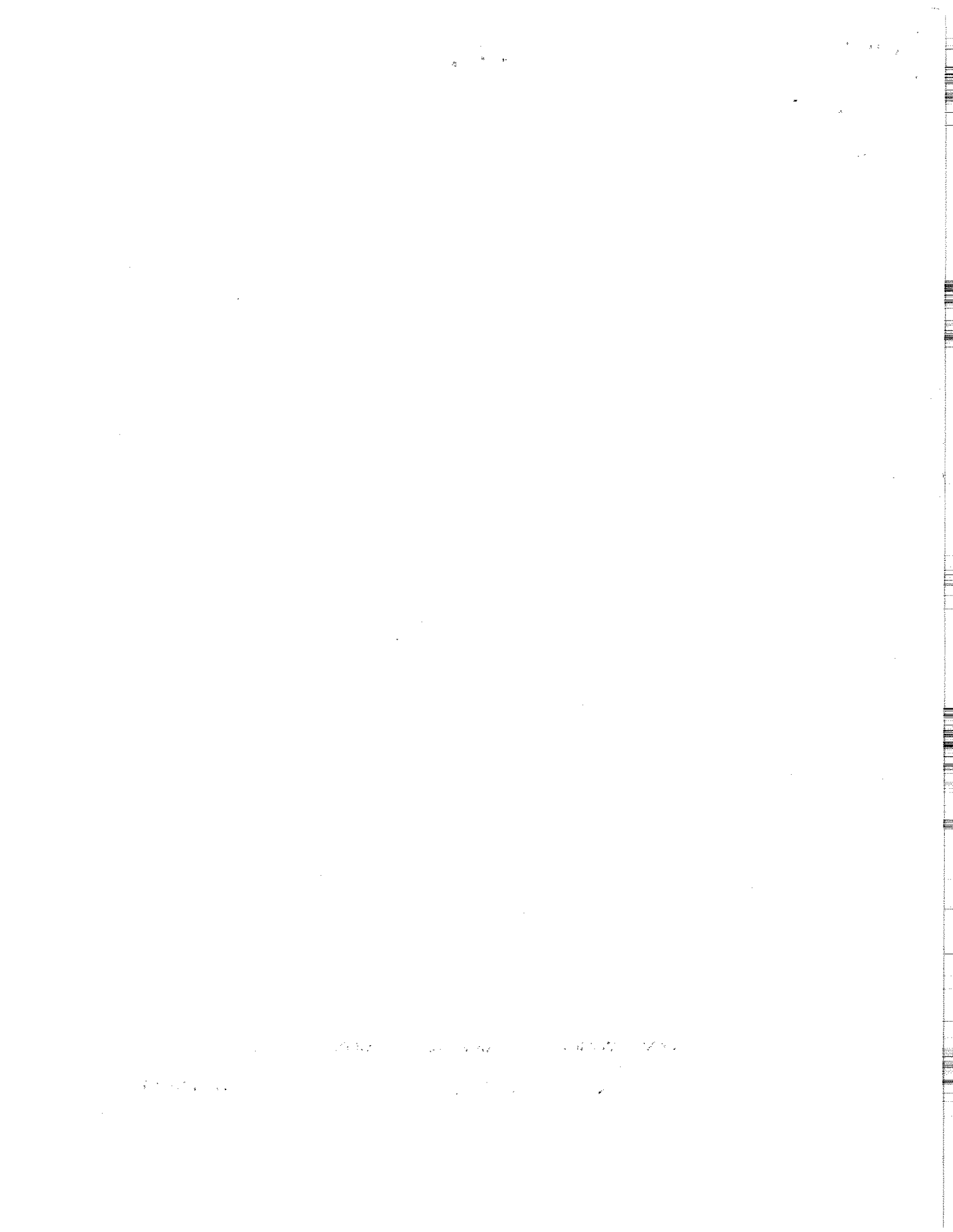
