3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125.00 registration fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Orders/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contract, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.

To provide operation, maintenance, and sampling of three (3) Waste Water Treatment Plants and four (4) Lift Stations at Cacapon Resort State Park in Berkeley Springs, West Virginia.

Contractor shall provide a certified Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator to maintain the sewage treatment plants in compliance with all state and federal regulations, laws, operation standards, and guidelines.

The contractor will:

Maintain the plants and lift stations in proper operating condition including, but not limited to, regulating operation of the automatic equipment, checking and changing oil in gear boxes, lubricating greased equipments, inspection for wear, planning equipment over haul, scrapping hoppers, washing down the plant, controlling the sludge for disposal, keeping chlorinators operating, keeping plants operations. Service trucks must carry a complete set of mechanics tools to facilitate repairs during plant visits.

Perform all control tests including chlorine residual, temperature, clarity in clarifiers, PH, dissolved oxygen in mixed liquor and effluent and sludge volume tests.

Keep complete operating records including test results, DMR reports, meter readings, plant operating observations, maintenance, and laboratory results. These records will be kept by the contractor with complete copies provided to park management. A complete copy of all reports is to be mailed to the park immediately upon receipt by the vendor.

Make repairs on all equipment.

Be on call in case of emergencies 24 hours a day, seven day a week. Vendor will provide emergency contact name, telephone number, and secondary number.

Meet with representatives of regulatory agencies when they visit the treatment facility.

Provide sampling for the laboratory analysis on the plant's effluent, which is required by the discharge permit and submit the required Discharge Monitoring Reports to the WV Division of Environmental Protection. Copies of the reports are to be forwarded to Cacapon State park management and to Mr. Steve Debarr, WV Division of Parks and Recreation, State Capitol Complex Building #3, Charleston, WV 25305. Cost of testing and sampling to be the responsibility of the contractor.

Maintain Four (4) effluent lift stations. These stations are to be visited as often as necessary to insure their efficient operation. Operator will immediately respond to problems reported by the park staff.

Maintain Two (2) sewage treatment plants: one (1) located in the Middle Fork cabin area and one (1) located in the North Fork cabin area. These plants are to be visited by certified plant operator a minimum of two (2) times per week. Operator will immediately respond to problems reported by park staff.

Chlorine, Dechlor Tablets, Bacteria, Enzymes, and other various and sundry materials and chemicals necessary for the operation of all sewage treatment facilities will be purchased and paid for by the contractor. The operator will keep accurate records of all materials purchased along with their cost and provide this information to Cacapon State Park management on a monthly basis.

The main sewage treatment plant located near the park entrance will be visited seven (7) days a week.

All wastewater treatment plant sand filters must be kept clean of grass, weeds, and waste materials at all times. The removal and replacement of the sand for the filters and drying beds will be the responsibility of the operator. The cost of these projects will be the responsibility of the vendor. Cost/amount accounting of these projects will be forwarded to park management as they are completed.

Operator must have a minimum of three (3) years full time experience as a waste water treatment plant operator.

Cost for the disposal of sand filter rakins and of waste sludge will be the responsibility of the contractor. Cost/amount accounting of these projects will be forwarded to the park management as they are completed.

The Middle Fork sewage plant has a polishing pond which will need to be maintained in proper operating condition by the contractor. Pond is to be kept free of floating weeds and debris.

The two mountain cabin sewage plants have two (2) septic tanks. If these tanks need to be pumped, this cost will be charged to the park's account. If the contractor finds that this work is necessary, he is to report it to the park staff immediately.

Copies of all reports and records maintained by the contractor will be provided to park management on a monthly basis no later than the 10th day of the following month.

Contractor will perform all maintenance and repairs on all treatment plants and lift station including on electric motors and pumps, chlorine contact chambers, ponds, collections lines, flow meters, and all other equipment necessary for proper plant operation.

The park will be (extra) charged for repair parts and motor shop work only. Contractor must request and receive approval from park management prior to replacing or repairing

equipment or parts. Contractor will provide cost accounting information on all repair parts to park management. Contractor will provide repair parts at their cost with no mark up. If it is determined by park management that equipment part replacement has been made necessary by a failure to properly maintain that equipment with preventative maintenance by the contractor, then that equipment's replacement cost or repair will be the responsibility of the contractor.

Contractor is responsible for the cost of sludge pumping from wastewater plants sufficient to maintain plants in proper working conditions or at the direction of park management. All records of sludge removal shall be maintained by the contractor with copies provide to park management. Contractors hauling sludge shall have proper permits in accordance with all state and federal regulations concerning hauling and disposal of sludge.

All sludge tests must be kept up to date. Sludge drying filter beds are to be kept clean at all times and free of other material and/or debris. Only sludge from Cacapon sewage plants may be upon drying beds. This ill keep sludge drying beds in proper working order and keep sludge pumping at a minimum.

Contractor must submit current application wastewater operator state certifications for all personnel involved in operation and maintenance of wastewater plants. These certifications must be in the hands of park management before any work commences by any individual.

If the park is charged with a violation of state and federal laws or regulations governing wastewater treatment facilities during the term of this contract due to negligence on the part of the vendor in operating and maintaining wastewater plants or failure of the contractor to comply with all applicable state and federal regulations, the cost of the fines and/or violations will be the responsibility of the contractor.

Liquidated Damages:

According to West Virginia State Code §5A-3-4(8), Vendor agrees that liquidated damages shall be imposed at the rate of **\$150.00** per day for failure to provide deliverables, meet miles stones identified to keep the project on target, or failure to meet specified deadlines This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue to any other additional remedy to which the State or Agency may have legal cause for action including further damages against the Vendor.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, West Virginia Insurance Commission, or any other state agencies or political subdivision. Furthermore, the vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the Director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.

CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures and rules.
