REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.

1. SPECIFICATIONS

The following sections of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, Standard Specifications, Roads and Bridges, adopted 2000, as modified by the current Supplemental Specifications shall apply to the administration of this contract: Sections 101, 102.4, 102.5, 105.13, 106.6, 106.8, 106.9, 107.1, 107.2, 107.3, 107.14, 107.19, 107.20, 108.8, 109.1, 109.2, and 109.20.

The terms "Contractor" and "Vendor" used in the above specifications of this contract are interchangeable. Contractor shall mean Vendor and Vendor shall mean Contractor.

2. BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of this contract is to provide for the trucking of approximately 20,000 tons of Sodium Chloride (rock salt) to the Bragg DOH location. See Item 5. Bid Schedule for exact location.

3. WEIGHING MATERIALS DELIVERED BY TRUCK

Material delivered by truck shall be weighed in accordance with Section 308.5 of the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, Standard Specifications, Road and Bridges, adopted 2000 as modified by the current Supplemental Specifications.

4. VENDOR'S INVOICES

Vendors are encouraged to utilize a paperless invoice process submitting the following information via e-mail to the DOH ordering location:

- a) All Weight Ticket numbers for material delivered during the invoicing period.
- b) Division of Highways Contract Number.
- c) Total quantity of tons and miles and unit price with the total cost.
- d) Vendor shall invoice in 5000 Ton increments (+ 5%) as deliveries are completed.

DELIVERY

Original delivery tickets for each delivered load to the Division's storage site must be signed and retained by a WVDOH employee at the delivery location.

5. BID SCHEDULE

Bid Item Transport Division of Highways (DOH) road salt from Rukart Terminal, 2021 South Clinton Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21224 to West Virginia DOH Storage Lot, 200 Samaritan Drive, Shady Springs (Bragg), West Virginia 25918 (take I-64 Exit #133, proceed North on CR 27 for a distance of 0.55 miles, turn right and follow the signs 0.20 miles to the end of the road).

Total approximate distance one way is 333 miles. This mileage figure is for information only; the vendor shall determine their own, most direct route.

Unit bid price \$ 0.1475* per ton-mile.

Payment shall be based upon one-way trip from terminal to storage lot.

$$*.1475/\text{ton mile} \times (333 \text{ miles}) = \$49.11/\text{ton} \\ \times 20,000 \text{ ton} = \$982,200.00$$

As of September 24, 2008, Rukart Terminal is open from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday. It is the vendor's responsibility to coordinate the loading of the salt with the terminal.

Preferred delivery hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday, except holidays; other hours by arrangement, two business days prior notice required. Contact name and phone number to be provided to successful bidder.

VENDOR PREFERENCE CERTIFICATE

Certification and application* is hereby made for Preference in accordance with West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37. (Does not apply to construction contracts). West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. Such preference is an evaluation method only and will be applied only to the cost bid in accordance with the West Virginia Code. This certificate for application is to be used to request such preference. The Purchasing Division will make the determination of the Resident Vendor Preference, if applicable.

Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked: Bidder is a resident vendor who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees working on the project being bid are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,
3. Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked: Bidder is a nonresident vendor employing a minimum of one hundred state residents or is a nonresident vendor with an affiliate or subsidiary which maintains its headquarters or principal place of business within West Virginia employing a minimum of one hundred state residents who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees or Bidder's affiliate's or subsidiary's employees are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,


