All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.



PRODUCT SPECIFICATION

F-40EX-F-TPILOT

DESCRIPTION: Compression testing machine for testing concrete cylinders, beams, cubes, masonry, brick, rock samples and a variety of other products.

CAPACITY: 400,000 lbf. compression.

RANGE: 4,000 lbf. to 400,000 lbf.

SYSTEM DESIGN: The F-40EX-F-TPILOT series machines are of a single-unit, self-contained design. The load readout, hydraulic pump and control valve are directly connected to the compression unit. Single unit design permits easy installation and provides portability without disassembling of hydraulic or electrical components.

COMPRESSION UNIT CONSTRUCTION: The load frame is manufactured from solid steel into a one-piece, welded unit. The vertical side members to be 1.75" thick x 11.00" wide and the top and bottom crossheads to be 3.50" thick x 11.00" wide x 11.00" deep. The unit to be designed to reduce deflection under full load, with frame rigidity expressed as 35.7×10^6 lbf/in. The hydraulic power piston assembly to be bolted to the bottom of the load frame with force applied in an upward direction.

- A. INSIDE DIMENSIONS: The compression area of the load frame has a vertical daylight opening of 19.00", and a horizontal opening of 11.00". These dimensions are without test accessories.
- B. OUTSIDE DIMENSIONS: Including the electrically operated hydraulic pump, the outside dimensions are 64 1/2" overall height x 31" overall width x 17" overall depth.

LOWER COMPRESSION PLATEN: The lower platen is 2.50" thick by 9.25" wide by 15.00" deep. The platen surface to be hardened to a Rockwell hardness of not less than 60 Rc and be precision ground to maintain planeness within .0005" in any 6.00" direction. The platen surface to be scribed with a center line and concentric circles for test specimen centering and be electroplated with industrial hard chrome for wear and rust resistance. The platen to be directly mounted to the top of the power piston to prevent foreign matter from entering the piston and cylinder assembly.

HYDRAULIC RAM ASSEMBLY: Testing pressure is applied by a 7.75" diameter power piston. Stability length of the piston is 6 1/4", and the working stroke is 2 1/2". Precision ground and polished to an 8 RMS finish, the piston is mounted in a polished solid steel cylinder with a non-frictional "0" ring and Teflon back-up

 ring for sealing.

HYDRAULIC PUMPING SYSTEM: The hydraulic pressure is supplied to the power piston assembly by a special two-stage pump. This power pump features a supercharger (first stage) which provides low-pressure, high-volume delivery for rapid advance of the ram to the specimen. Once system pressure exceeds 100 p.s.i., the single piston pump (stage two) automatically takes over to delivery high-pressure, low-volume flow to machine capacity. Directly connected to the electric motor shaft, this pump runs immersed in oil rendering it maintenance free.

HYDRAULIC CONTROL SYSTEM: A single automatic control valve with multiple loading and unloading functions as outlined in items A thru D is used.

- A. METERED ADVANCE: This loading feature maintains stress loading adjustable from 2,000 pounds to 200,000 pounds per minute. Once set, the rate of loading will automatically be maintained by the pressure compensating valve until it is either readjusted, or the test specimen reaches its yield point.
- B. FULL ADVANCE: The rapid traverse lever is used to position the compression platen at the rate of 2 1/2" travel per minute. This feature is most often used for rapid advancement of the hydraulic ram prior to making contact with the specimen. It can also be used for pre-loading of specimens.
- C. HOLD: Pressure advance can be stopped and held to inspect the alignment of the test sample or interrupt the test cycle.
- D. RETRACT: This function is for the release of pressure and return of the compression platen to the start position or total retract.

LOAD READOUT SYSTEM: See Test Pilot product data sheet.

ELECTRICAL SPECIFICATIONS: The hydraulic pump motor is rated at 110/220 volts, 12.0/6.0 full load amps. Single phase, 50/60 Hz current is required. Standard motor develops 3/4 horsepower.

ACCESSORY SYSTEM: Accessories are held in the compression unit by means of a holding stem system. This holding stem is inserted into the hydraulic piston and held by a locking setscrew.

UNIT WEIGHT: Complete unit weight without accessories is 1,170 lbs.

SHIPPING: F-40EX-F-TPILOT machines are shipped in an upright position, bolted to a wooden skid and crated. Total shipping weight can vary, depending upon type and number of accessories ordered, as they are included in the same shipping crate.

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PRODUCT SPECIFICATION TEST PILOT LOAD MONITOR

DESCRIPTION: The Test Pilot digital load monitor is a microprocessor-based instrument for measurement of applied loads to compression, tension and flexural load frames for the testing of concrete, steel and cement products. It is composed of aluminum housing with large anti-scratch overlay, sixteen button keypad, and power entry module with filter, fuse and power switch and connectors for 2 force channels and 2 lvdt strain channels, one RS-232 communications port and download printing capability. This load monitor is a menu driven instrument with the following features:

- Indicates live load, peak load, peak stress, load rate, specimen area, date, time, memory register
- Analyzes test data to calculate key test parameters i.e. 's stress and modulus of rupture
- Produces X-Y (load versus time) plots in Excel

LOAD MONITOR: The load monitor consists of a single display for monitoring test information and a keypad for data entry. The displayed information by line is date, time, memory register, specimen area, load, stress, rate, rate indicators. Date, time, memory register, test number, specimen shape, specimen size, and area, load stress and load rate is then can be shown. The display is 16 character backlit LCD.

KEYPAD: The keypad is used for direct entry of specimen identification number, specimen type, specimen size, units of load (LB, KN, or Kg), units of stress (P.S.I., kPa or ksc), units of length (in. or mm) and units of time (min. or sec.). These functions are displayed under specialized menu keys. The arrow keys are used to input specimen information and move between menus.

REPORT GENERATION: Up to 500 tests can be stored in permanent battery backed memory, ASCII delimited format. Once the sample break detection locks onto the highest load value (test result) the Test Pilot monitor displays maximum force in the selected units (English or metric): The test result can be stored in memory automatically, sent to an IBM compatible PC via an optional RS-232 interface for hard copy reporting and further data reports,

X-Y graphics at the computer.

A typical printout from the data display contains the following information:


