- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.

Technical Concerns:

In ereviewing the specifications set forth in the RFQ I have a couple of concerns that I would like to present for your general information.

1 (Heavy Duty Loader) Bullet 2: Lift Capacity of 4,495# from 0' to 5'

Concern: Per attached Kubota literature, the Kubota LA1153 Loader, which is the OEM recommended loader for this series tractor, shows that maximum lift capacity is rated at only 2,326 to 2,536#. I do not see how you can request a minimum lift capacity as stated when the manufacture of the tractor only rates the maximum lift capacity as stated in their specification literature. The Stoll loader may have the ability to lift the higher capacity but the Kubota Tractor is not designed or rated for the same load.

- 2 (BH90-X Backhoe) Bullet 4: How do you define the hydraulic attachment of the backhoe to the tractor? (a) Through the rear remote valves. (b) By virtue of a Power Beyond Kit.
- 3 (Agricultural Tractor) Bullet 8: 3-point hitch lift capacity 3,307#. Kubota achieves this rating by utilizing 2 auxiliary lift cylinders (slave cylinder) attached to their rock shaft. John Deere achieves a lift capacity of 3,192# on their standard tractor without the use of the auxiliary cylinders. On a similar John Deere tractor in this horsepower range that does use the auxiliary lift cylinders we achieve a lift capacity of 4,498#.
