REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.

Open-End Contract:

Any contract resulting from this Request for Quote shall be Open-End. The vendor understands and agrees that quantities stated are approximations only and that the contract shall cover the quantities actually ordered for delivery during the term of the contract, whether more or less than the quantities shown.

Evaluation & Award:

Award shall be made to the lowest bid vendor(s) meeting specifications.

The State reserves the right to make multiple awards if in the best interest of the State to do so.

The State reserves the right to request samples for testing during the evaluation process. Do not include samples with the bid. Vendors will be contacted, if necessary, to provide samples during the evaluation process. Samples shall be provided at no cost to the State. Vendor shall pay for return shipping, if desired.

Contract Administration:

The Vendor shall name a dedicated contact to be responsible for all issues related to the contract prior to the award.

Training:

Telephone and/or online training shall be provided for all magnifiers.

Packaging:

Each magnifier shall be provided with a Protective Case and shall include large print instructions.

Warranty:

All magnifiers shall have a full one year warranty from time of receipt of each magnifier ordered. Warranty shall cover all bulbs, repairs, parts and shipping to and from the vendor's repair facility. Any bulbs that dim from their original brightness level during the 1 year warranty shall be replaced at no cost.

Shipping Terms:

All bids shall be FOB Destination, inclusive of shipping cost.

Hand-Held Magnifier Specifications:

All Hand-Held Magnifiers must meet the following specifications:

1. 5mm minimum 4 chips or diodes through-hole light emitting diodes (LED) and 12 ohm resistor design.
