REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.





REGARDING: Alcohol and Drug Free Work Environment Policies

RAM Construction Services has a strong commitment to its employees, to its clients and to the community: To provide a safe workplace in which we can produce a quality product, and to safeguard the health and safety to our employees and the general public.

Consistent with our commitment, the goal of RAM Construction Services is to create and maintain an alcohol and drug free work environment. Therefore, the company has established the following policies/procedures to create an alcohol and drug free workplace and workforce.

For the purpose of these policies/procedures:

- (1) "On the Job" - Shall be defined as during working hours or at anytime while representing the company or during working or non-working hours while on company property, on company projects, or while driving a company vehicle.
- (2) "Drugs" - Shall be defined as any controlled or illicit substance, other than a drug prescribed for the employee by a doctor. If any employee must for medical reasons use a medication that could potentially affect work performance, it is the responsibility for that employee to notify his or her immediate supervisor prior to reporting to work.
- (3) "Alcohol" - Shall be defined as a colorless flammable liquid that is the intoxicating agent in fermented and distilled liquors.
- (4) "Under the Influence" means that in management's view of the facts, the employee's behavior or ability to safely and efficiently perform the job may be adversely affected. You should resolve all doubts by not coming to work with alcohol or drugs in your system, except prescription drugs.

- (5) Engaging in the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, sale, transfer, storage, concealment, transportation, promotion, or use of a controlled substance, alcoholic beverages, or drug-related paraphernalia by employees and others at the workplace or while conducting RAM Construction Services business off the company's premises.

The company recognizes that the use of alcohol and other drugs can be a safety and health hazard to the employee and their co-workers. Therefore, it is the policy of RAM Construction Services that all employees shall be free of the presence of drugs and the influence of alcohol when they report to work or at anytime when on company property, representing the company, or when handling company property. If any employee is caught using drugs or alcohol "on the job", the employee will be subject to mandatory disciplinary action, up to and including discharge

The goal of our policy is to discourage the use of any substance which may interfere with employee's health, safety, or personal and professional success. To ensure an alcohol and drug free workforce, RAM Construction Services has implemented the following policies, procedures, and programs.

- (1) Pre-Employment Testing
All applicants for employment will be tested for drugs at the company's expense. If any prospective new hire refuses to provide a urine drug screen sample, attempts to provide an invalid or fraudulent sample or if results confirm the presence of drugs, the applicant will not be hired.
- (2) Reasons for Alcohol and Drug Testing
Employees will be tested for drugs and alcohol for the following reasons:
- (A) Personal injury accident.
 - (B) Involvement in any incident which results in personal injury, damage or loss of any property.
 - (C) Observable signs of impaired behavior.
 - (D) Drug or alcohol testing at-will, notwithstanding items A, B or C above management reserves the right.

Any employee refusing to submit to a drug screen or showing a confirmed positive test result for drugs, or alcohol shall be subject to disciplinary action up to discharge

Any employee showing a confirmed positive test result shall be required to complete a professional evaluation/and corrective therapy along with a clean drug screen test prior to being deemed fit for duty

After the confirmed positive test result the employee will be subject to at-will drug testing for

a twelve (12) month period following his/her return to the job.

If an employee's test confirms a positive test result during the at-will drug testing period, or the employee is subject to Items #A, #B, #C or #D listed above within a thirty-six (36) month period, the employee will be required to complete a minimum 14 day in-patient rehabilitation. This will count as the employee's second chance. **Upon returning to work, employee will be drug tested at-will twice a month for a six-month period to insure that the employee is remaining drug free.**

If an employee's test confirms a positive test result during the at-will drug testing period, or the employee is subject to Item #A, #B, #C or #D, a third time the employee will be terminated.

(3) Rehabilitation for Drug or Alcohol Addiction

RAM Construction Services recognizes that drug or alcohol use may be symptoms of the disease of chemical dependency.

The company wants to encourage any persons with concerns about their alcohol or drug use to **voluntarily** seek treatment to recover. RAM Construction Services will assist in finding the appropriate rehabilitation for the employee's problem. After a successful completion of the rehabilitation the employee will return to his/her former position.

RAM Construction Services is committed to support any voluntary admission employee up to and through two (2) rehabilitations.

Failure to begin or complete corrective therapy or the appropriate rehabilitation after voluntarily admitting a problem (drug or alcohol dependence) will result in disciplinary action up to and including discharge.

Implementation of Policy/Procedures
