REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
14. **HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM:** The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (<http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm>) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.

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**SCOPE:**

The Contractor will provide all Labor, Material, Equipment, Supervision, and other incidentals to provide thorough Inspection and Testing of the Sprinkler Systems for nine (9) West Virginia Regional Jail Facilities located throughout West Virginia. This will include, but is not limited to, sprinkler riser, tamper switch, flow switches, piping and connections, and sprinkler heads in all locations. The controlled inspection and testing will be conducted in accordance with NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) code and standards. Testing and Inspection will take place as often as recommended in accordance with NFPA code and WV State Law.

**OBJECTIVES:**

- Insure the nine (9) West Virginia Regional Jail Facilities listed are functioning in accordance with NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) codes and standards and West Virginia State Fire Marshals codes.
- Insure Life Safety equipment is working as designed to protect the well being of the occupants of the building.

**CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS:**

Experience: The Contractor shall possess at least two (2) years experience working in Inspection and Testing of Sprinkler System Equipment and provide proof of the proper certification to perform the work specified in this Request for Quotation. Personnel conducting the work on behalf of the vendor must be certified by the NFPA and the West Virginia State Fire Board Authority. A hard copy of this certification must be included with vendors bid response.

Bidding Contractor must comply with all requirements set forth by NFPA codes and standards, and West Virginia State Code for inspection and Testing of Sprinkler Systems.

The Contractor shall submit within seven working days upon request, a statement signed by a company officer listing the following information:

- A record of any citations issued by Federal, State, or Local Regulatory Authorities relating to Inspection and Testing Services;
- A statement that explains any litigation or arbitration proceedings related to the contractor/personnel's performance of a contract for inspection and testing services;
- A statement as to whether any procurement laws in the State of West Virginia would affect the potential award of a contract to the contractor for this project;

**GUIDELINES:**

The controlled inspection and testing will be conducted in accordance with all NFPA codes and standards regarding Inspection and Testing (NFPA 25).

**SERVICE LOCATIONS:** See Attached List.

**Note:** The information included on the Facility Information and Location Sheet is for the Contractor's information only. The facilities are designed in a podular manner. Each housing unit, or "pod", of the jail is divided into eight separate sections of eight or sixteen cells to accommodate the inmate population. Each section has a day room and each pod includes two secure outdoor recreation areas. The facility also has a gym and administration area. The contractor is responsible for verifying all information to his/her satisfaction. A pre-bid visit may be scheduled before 1/9/2009, by contacting the Facility Administrator listed on the attached Location Sheet. No change orders or additions to the bid price will be accepted due to the inaccuracy of the information provided on these sheets.

**Award of Contract:** Multiple awards may be made for this contract due to the location of the facilities. The West Virginia Regional Jail Authority with the approval of the Department of Administration, Purchasing Division, has the right to accept all or a portion of the bid amount. The cost for each building/facility shall include all Labor, Material, Equipment, Supervision, and other incidentals to provide Testing and Inspection Services for that building/facility.

**Time Frame of Service Visits:** Testing and Inspection will take place at least once a year or as often as recommended in accordance with NFPA code and West Virginia State Law. The Contractor shall coordinate all visits with the facility Administrator and Maintenance personnel. The contractor shall perform Inspections and Testing between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm.

The testing Contractor will inform the agency of any repairs needed to comply with NFPA and State codes and standards. The vendor will then submit a quote to the agency for approval prior to such repair. The quote needs to include the cost of parts, labor and any incidentals associated with the repair.

**Safety and Health:** The working environment is an operational regional jail facility and inspection and testing must be conducted in accordance with all West Virginia Regional Jail Authority protocol for working within an operational facility. The Contractor shall observe all safety precautions throughout the performance of this contract.
