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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, this Contract may be deemed null and void, and terminated without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that, the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 15. WEST VIRGINIA ALCOHOL & DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE ACT: If this Contract constitutes a public improvement construction contract as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code ("The West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act"), then the following language shall hereby become part of this Contract: "The contractor and its subcontractors shall implement and maintain a written drug-free workplace policy in compliance with the West Virginia Alcohol and Drug-Free Workplace Act, as set forth in Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. The contractor and its subcontractors shall provide a sworn statement in writing, under the penalties of perjury, that they maintain a valid drug-free work place policy in compliance with the West Virginia and Drug-Free Workplace Act. It is understood and agreed that this Contract shall be cancelled by the awarding authority if the Contractor: 1) Fails to implement its drug-free workplace policy; 2) Fails to provide information regarding implementation of the contractor's drug-free workplace policy at the request of the public authority; or 3) Provides to the public authority false information regarding the contractor's drug-free workplace policy."

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
The West Virginia State Rail Authority wishes to solicit bids for a vendor to design and install a camera surveillance system at the Duffields MARC Train Parking Lot in Jefferson County, West Virginia. The parking lot is located along Flowing Springs Road in Duffields, WV.

This addendum completely replaces the original RFQ. All changes from the original will be in italics. Removed sections will be shown as strikethroughs.

Section 1. Description of property and utility contact information.

- o The parking lot contains approximately 199 parking spaces.
- o The Parking Lot is lighted. Lighting is provided by Alleghany Power who owns the lights and poles. The State Rail Authority pays a monthly rental fee and the electric usage. Allegheny Power's contact information is:

Telephone lines border the property. They are located at the edge of Flowing Springs Road and are overhead. Frontier services the Duffields area. Their contact information is:

o The first parking lot closest to the railroad tracks is owned by CSX Transportation and simply leased by the State Rail Authority. If it is necessary to do anything to this property you will need to get permission from CSX. Their contact information is:

Section 2. Desired Attributes of System ---

- o System shall be capable of covering the entire parking lot and passenger loading platforms.
- System shall be able to store at least one week of video System will be able to store 30 days of 24/7 feed.
- Cameras shall be of sufficient quality to allow identification of vehicle, individuals, and license plate numbers. Cameras should also be able to pan the parking lot if needed. They shall be Outdoor 6-60MM Vari Focal Lens 520 TVL RES, IR Cameras or equivalent. A minimum of four cameras shall be installed. Two cameras will need focused at each entrance with cameras capable of identifying vehicles, individuals and license plate numbers. Two cameras will be directed toward the parking lots and have panning capability. The system is to be a complete remote system that has IP cameras. Five wireless fixed point cameras and one panning camera.
- Vendor shall supply a 4 channel DVR with 160GB, USP, and IP with a lock box and dual fans. That will be located at the Moorefield office. Vendor will be responsible to install DVR at Moorefield location.

- O System shall be able to broadcast over the internet using a DSL connection. Vendor will supply a Cisco router or equivalent and all power supplies, pole mounts and compatible wiring to have a 24/7 internet feed. Contractor will install three poles in the trench by the CSXT lot and one pole in the second trench between the last two parking areas. These poles will be used to mount the cameras.
- o System shall require a user id and password for access. State Rail Authority shall have full control of who is granted access.

Section 3. Scope of Work

- o Contractor shall provide all equipment and wiring necessary for system.
- o Contractor shall install all equipment and wiring necessary for system.
 - The system will require a climate controlled environment for recording and/or transmission equipment, contractor shall provide the necessary building or cabinet. Cabinet or building shall be lockable and tamper proof.
 - o Contractor shall make all electrical and telephone connections required.
 - o Contractor shall turn the system over to the State Rail Authority complete and ready to use.

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o Contractor will install sign stating the lot is under camera surveillance.

Section 4. Contractor responsibility

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- o Contractor shall provide at least a two year full parts and labor warranty
- o Contractor is responsible for communications with electric company, telephone company, and/or any other contacts required.
- o All work shall be done in a professional manner and all garbage shall be gathered up and disposed of.
- o Contractor is responsible for any and all traffic control necessary.

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- o Contractor shall provide all locks and will provide State Rail Authority with (2) two keys for each lock used.
- o Contractor will avoid working within 4 feet of the edge of the ties on the CSXT mainline. Should contractor do so and be fined by Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), contractor bears full responsibility for all costs involved.

Section 5. Miscellaneous

O Cameras will not be installed on westbound side of CSX Transportation's main. That is the platform opposite the parking lot. The reason for this is to avoid placing cable under the CSXT Mainline. Camera(s) covering that platform will be placed on parking lot side of tracks.

Section 6 - Bidding

- o Project shall be bid as one lump sum bid. This price will include all labor, material and miscellaneous expenses associated with installing a surveillance system that will cover the Duffields parking area.
- o The contractor will make the initial calls to the various companies for DSL service and electrical services as needed for the system. After the initial set up, the SRA will be fully responsible for the monthly costs to service this location.
- A pre-bid meeting will be held on December 9, 2008 at 11:00 am. at the Duffields
 parking lot for anyone interested in viewing the work site. Questions prior to the
 pre-bid inspection must be submitted in writing and will be addressed at the

- o Vendor must be able to have a working system in place within 45 days after contract is awarded.
- O Contractor will use Heavy and Highway Construction Rates as established for Jefferson County. These rates are pursuant to WV Code 21-5A, et. Seq. and are available at www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates.
