GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. All quotations are governed by the West Virginia Code and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division.
- 4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
- 12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 13. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 14. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, and available online at the Purchasing Division's web site (http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm) is hereby made part of the agreement. SPECIFICATION SECTION DEP14157 – Tube Settler System

The following equipment is designed for tube settler coverage of two (2) basin areas 15'-0" wide x 45'-0" long.

 $A - 1.350 \text{ ft}^2$

ENVIROPAX 60° "24 inch" tube settler modules constructed of PVC plastic material. The tube shall be molded at 60° angles in the plastic material to provide a stronger module pack. Plastic material shall have a minimum of 20 mil thickness corrugated sheet and 20 mil thickness flat sheet to enhance module strength and increase resistance to damage from handling. The modules will be formed in configurations to the required length and width to minimize if not eliminate field cutting and trimming. Enviropax tube settlers are classified as meeting ANSI/NSF 61 Standards.

 $B - 200 \text{ ft}^2$

Spare tube settlers provided as twenty (20) modules 1'-0" wide x 10'-0" long or ten (10) modules 2'-0" wide x 10'-0" long.

Effluent collection troughs 12" x 12" x 18'-0" long provided with a flanged end connections. The troughs shall be provided with FRP V-notched weir plates. The troughs shall be constructed of ½" thick fiberglass and provided with 304 stainless steel fasteners and neoprene flange gasket material

D – Four (4) ea

Effluent collection troughs 12" x 12" x 26'-0" long provided with a flanged end connection and one end closed.. The troughs shall be provided with FRP V-notched weir plates. The troughs shall be constructed of ¼" thick fiberglass and provided with 304 stainless steel fasteners and neoprene flange gasket material

E-Two (2) sets

Supports for tube settlers to be fabricated of 304 stainless steel members for field bolting assembly by others. Each set of supports shall consist of the following:

- (6) tube settler support beams 15'-0"
- (6) cross braces 2'-0"
- (6) vertical trough supports
- (4) wall knee brace bracket support assembly
- (1 lot) wall clips
- (1 lot) epoxy set anchors (304 SS)
- (1 lot) assembly bolts (304 SS)
- F 1,350 ft²

Protective surface grating constructed of rigid fiberglass and provided in panel sections 4'-0" \times 12'-0", and 6'-0". The grating shall be a 2" \times 2" square mesh that is $\frac{1}{2}$ " high.

Spare protective surface grating.

COMMENTS TO SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. The specifications call out for baffles to be provided to direct the flow underneath the tube settler; however, the contract drawings show a concrete T beam supporting a walkway that acts as a baffle. Therefore, the baffles have not been included in this proposal since they are not needed.
- 2. The proposed "protective grating" is made of fiberglass reinforced plastic provided in 4'-0" x 12'-0" x ½" thick sections for increased rigidity in lieu of the plastic 24" square snap-together pieces specified. A cut sheet for the multigrid is attached.


