REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)**

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. All quotations are governed by the *West Virginia Code* and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division.
4. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
5. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods, this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
6. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
7. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
9. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
10. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
11. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern all rights and duties under the Contract, including without limitation the validity of this Purchase Order/Contract.
12. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
13. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

**Addendum #1 - Questions During Pre-Bid Meeting
For DEP 14770
Fisher Run (Posey) Subsidence & Portals Project**

The following questions were identified from the Pre-Bid Conference. The answers provided herein take precedence over verbal answers at the PBC should there be any conflicts between the two.

- 1.) **Q.** How will temporary fence be handled?
A. Temporary fencing may be required to segregate livestock from some of the construction areas. If it is required, it shall be installed at the locations and to the dimensions determined by consultation with the AML Representative on site. No more temporary fence than is necessary to prevent livestock from entering onto reclaimed disturbed area will be required. Payment will be included in the lump sum price bid for Site Preparation.
- 2.) **Q.** How will Fence Replacement be handled?
A. Existing fences that are necessarily removed to allow construction activities to take place shall be replaced in accordance with Specification 4.6. Payment for this work will be included in the lump sum price bid for Site Preparation.
- 3.) **Q.** Will any special provisions be necessary regarding temporary fencing to allow livestock access to water?
A. Yes. Either the WV Dept of Environmental Protection (WVDEP) will provide direction for development of a temporary water supply source for the livestock or the landowner will relocate the livestock to an area where water is available where temporary fencing may be utilized for containment. The actual livestock control Plan will be worked out at the time of construction as per the Construction Supervisor.
- 4.) **Q.** Are there double mine drainage outlet pipes crossing under the road from the mine seal installations that cross the road?
A. Yes.
- 5.) **Q.** Is the contractor responsible for submitting a Traffic Control Plan to the WVDOH for this work?
A. Yes.
- 6.) **Q.** What are the requirements associated with the access road construction?
A. That the disturbed area shall be revegetated upon completion of the project.
- 7.) **Q.** Are headwalls and endwalls incidental items?
A. No. There are bid items provided for each of these.
- 8.) **Q.** Are there piezometers located on the west side of the project as well?
A. No. Just the four piezometers on the east side.

The site review conducted after the scope of work discussion at the Pre-Bid Conference indicated that the slopes for the mine drainage channels on the west side of the project are significantly steeper than those on the east. Also, there was evidence of mine water discharging from one of the proposed mine seal installations on the west side of the project as well as those on the east side.

The bat gate installation is actually to take place in Portal #2 instead of Portal #3 as indicated on the plan drawings.

The Contractor shall have 90 days from the date of the Notice to Proceed to complete construction activities on the project. The \$250 per day liquidated damage clause will be in effect after the 90 days. However, the total performance period will be 365 days from the date of the Notice to Proceed for invoicing purposes.

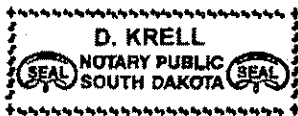

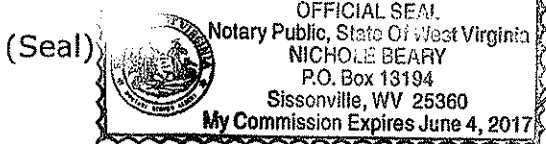
