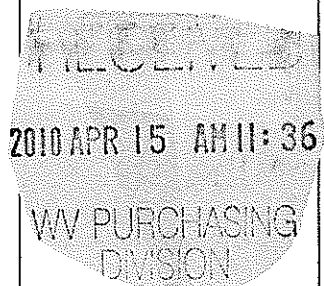

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

The following comments and questions were identified from the Pre-Bid Conference. The answers provided herein take precedence over verbal answers at the PBC should there be any conflict between the two.

Comments:

1. Work hours on this project shall be between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm Monday through Saturday. Work on Sundays and major holidays shall not be allowed.
2. Due to changes in the NPDES requirements silt fence will be required along any areas that would allow drainage to leave the project site. The approximate quantity of silt fence will be 550 lf and shall be bid under Section 5 Sediment control. No additional quantity is needed for this item.

Questions:

1. **Q.** Can we dry the wet material in an area outside the construction limits?
A. No. We can only work within the existing construction limits.
2. **Q.** Where does the cut timber need to be stacked for property owner?
A. We do not know the exact location that he will want it placed so plan on placing it by the main road at the access point where the PBC was held.
3. **Q.** Do we need to clear cut the area where the refuse is located?
A. Plan on only removing the trees that are necessary for the completion of the construction work.
4. **Q.** Can we bury the concrete building remains on the project site?
A. Yes, but only the concrete blocks. No other material associated with the building can be buried.
5. **Q.** Are there any hazardous materials in the drums located on the project site?
A. We do not know of any hazardous materials that are located on this site. But you need to be aware if any are discovered they must be handled by the hazardous waste standards for disposal.

6. **Q.** Will water treatment be required on this project?
 - A. Yes. Must meet pH and iron standard. A bid item for soda ash is included in the bid schedule.

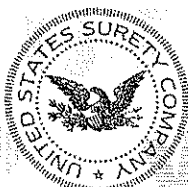

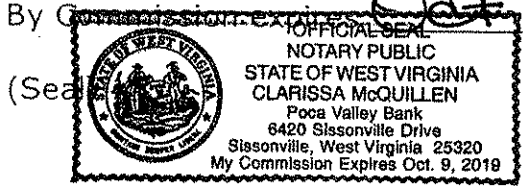

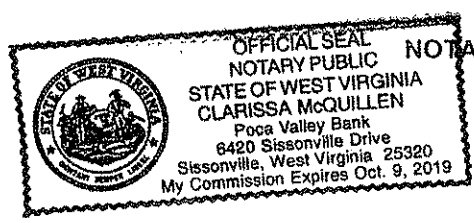
