

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to your RFP for Outside Plant Cabling and a new Voice-Over-IP telephone system for Cacapon State Park. Verizon Business is excited about providing these services to meet your needs.

Our proposal includes the response to the RFP and a "sample" of our systems agreement. We have provided pricing for the copper and fiber backbone portion of the RFQ as specified and are labeled "**Fiber and Copper Base Bid Price**". And in an effort to help reduce the project cost, we have included an alternate bid response for the copper and fiber backbone portion of the RFQ as well. It is labeled "**Fiber and Copper Alternate Bid Pricing**".

For the VOIP Telephone System portion of the RFQ and with careful consideration we have selected NEC as the manufacturer. We have provided pricing for an NEC SV8300 system as a substitution for the Alcatel/Lucent system requested. The NEC system contains all the hospitality software necessary for Guest Works. Verizon is a certified NEC Partner and we have provided references.

Also, in an effort to help reduce costs of this project to Cacapon State Park and WV DNR, we are willing to accept <u>all or partial</u> award of this RFQ. We would accept either the Fiber and Copper Backbone, the Fiber and Copper Backbone Alternate or the VOIP Telephone System portion of the RFQ.
