- Page One must have one sided printing and be printed on scannable-mark reflex paper; Side One must have a unique license number pre-printed and pre-slugged for scanning; and weight of paper must be .0123 pounds and size dimensions must be 9 inches by 11 inches for combatibility with the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources' NCS Opscan 10 Scanner.
  - All bubble grids on Page One must be scannable and their locations identified precisely by track marks along the the page margin. In addition, the unique license control number on West Virginia Sporting License must be litho-coded, scanner-readable sequential binary number on each form and scannable.

## **Liquidated Damages:**

Liquidated damages will be assessed at \$100.00 per day for late delivery, unless written authorization for a later shipping date is issued by the director of state purchasing or designee.

#### Form Deficiencies:

If any forms do not scan properly due to defective materials and/or products used in the form manufacturing process, the Vendor is responsible for having all data normally collected and delivered by the scanning program keyed and blind verified and delivered to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resource within thirty (30) days of receipt by the Vendor of the bad forms. Vendor will be responsible for all costs for keying, shipping, and charge the Vendor the time spent in preparing forms to be shipped to the Vendor. Data format that shall be used will be supplied by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. Keyed data will be delivered electronically to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. ## Testing:

# **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its **DEFINITIONS:** political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (West Virginia Code §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
