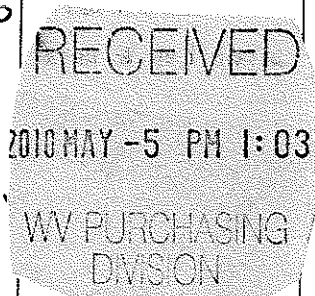

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT
