YES

1.2 Are these values such that a 12.5khz/25khz design would meet the requirement? -

NO, VHF channels are 15kHz and 30kHz. UHF channels are 12.5kHz and 25kHz to the best of my knowledge.

1.3 Does this apply for both digital and analog operation of the radio? -

Yes, the channels do not become narrower with digital operation, only the modulation.

1.4 Doesn't 15khz still violate narrow band requirements? --

Not for VHF.

COR is used to indicated a change of state in the receiver indicating receive or lack of receive. Carrier present changes this state, thus CARRIER operated relay (or equivalent) as indicated in the specifications.


