General Instrument Specification

In response to your letter asking Bio-Rad Laboratories to sign a Business Associate Agreement, clause #13 with respect to HIPAA, please be advised that Bio-Rad is not a Business Associate under the definition of HIPAA, as it does not receive protected health information from you. Please be advised that the State of West Virginia is prohibited from producing any personal health care information to Bio-Rad. If Bio-Rad inadvertently receives such information, Bio-Rad will return this information immediately without review and will not retain any copies.

Per the Confidentiality clause #14, please change to read: "For the purpose of this Agreement, confidential information ("Confidential Information") shall be labeled "Confidential" and shall mean all proprietary, secret or confidential information or data relating to State of West Virginia or Bio-Rad Laboratories and their respective operations, employees, services or customers. Each party agrees to: (i) maintain the confidentiality of the other's Confidential Information, (ii) not-disclose Confidential Information to third parties without the express written permission of the disclosing party, and (iii) use Confidential Information solely to advance the purpose of this Agreement. Confidential Information does not include: information that, a) was in the receiving party's possession before receipt from the disclosing party; b) is or becomes available to the public through no fault of the receiving party; c) is received in good faith by the receiving party from a third party and is not subject to an obligation of confidentiality owed to the third party; or d) is independently developed by the receiving party without reference to information received under this Agreement."

Please delete #16, Antitrust language. Bio-Rad can not assign our interests and rights under an antitrust lawsuit should we potentially suffer damages as a result of the antitrust actions of another party. We will agree that the Attorney General of West Virginia may act as lead counsel in any action involving the products at issue in this agreement if the State of West Virginia possesses financial interests equal to or greater than those of Bio-

Rad. Bio-Rad reserves the right to hire counsel at its own expense to protect Bio-Rad's interests and to provide assistance to the Attorney General of West Virginia.
