GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

Award Conditions

The award shall be based on the lowest-cost provider meeting the specifications. The evaluation of this contract shall be done by multiplying the usage figures times the bidder's discounted unit prices. The extended total shall be the basis to determine the low bidder.

All items stating "must" or "shall" are mandatory requirements. Failure to provide or meet any of these mandatory requirements shall be grounds to disqualify the entire quotation.

Samples of all items bid are required. These samples must be received no later than five (5) days after the bid opening date. If bidder wishes to have samples returned, they must include a pre-paid label or other information to have the items returned at vendor's expense. All samples shall be tested. Samples must be capable of picking up a brick without bending the grabber and must also be capable of picking up a dime.

Litter 10A notes

Civic Enterprises originally patented our 30" Grab-It® in September of 1970. We have been in constant production since that time. That size is so named, because we start with a 30" tube. The finished product does actually measure 31 1/2" from tip of handle to tip of cups. The Grab-It® is manufactured from anodized aluminum and weighs in at about 8 ounces. I submit that this will meet the criteria for the 32" Regular grabber requested in your specifications Conversely, our 36" model, which we only recently introduced, starts with a 36" tube, and measures about 37 ½ longest dimension. This size weighs in at just under 10 ounces, and while not having the strength of tubular steel, it provides the user with a good balance of extra reach without having to carry an overly heavy tool for long periods. Several DOT's who expressed needing the longer length are now requesting this product. Samples of both models are being shipped via UPS on April 12.

We ship 10's of thousands of our standard 30" model each year, but being a newly introduced item, we have not built as big a following for the 36" model as yet. Therefore, we only normally stock about 1000 –1250 of the 36" model. Should we receive word that we are the apparent winning bidder, we are prepared to ship whatever stock we have on hand, and immediately tool up to produce the remainder in a timely manner. If the orders/useage were staggered through the year, this would not even become an issue.

We are proud to say that we have produced a quality tool for almost 40 years. We are an American owned, small business, and our product is manufactured here in the US. We appreciate the opportunity to present this bid and if named the winner, look forward to providing a high level of customer service that has earned us many repeat customers throughout the years.
