- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

REQUEST FOR QUOTE

The West Virginia Purchasing Division, for the West Virginia State Rail Authority (SRA), is soliciting bids for the repair of railroad bridges on the South Branch Valley Railroad (SBVR) and West Virginia Central Railroad (WVCR).

SOUTH BRANCH VALLEY RAILROAD - (7 BRIDGES)

BRIDGE 4.2

SBVR 4.2 consists of a three span structure that crosses over Green Spring Run in Hampshire County, WV. The spans total approximately 35' - 1" in length. The structure is an open deck timber trestle that consists of timber stringers supported on timber bents and piling. The stringers are grouped in two chords of four in Spans 1 and 3, and two chords of three in Span 2, bolted together, and located below each rail. The backwalls are composed of timber.

Description of work for Bridge 4.2

• Contractor is to correct poor vertical and horizontal alignment at north approach. On the east rail, raise the ballast to remove the gap between the bottom of the rail and the rail support plate at the north approach. On the west rail, raise the ballast to remove the gap between the bottom of the rail and the rail support plate at the north approach. Add ballast and reset ties in the approach, and shim the stringers at the north abutment.

BRIDGE 8.9

SBVR 8.9 crosses over a stream/farm road in Hampshire County, WV. It is a five span bridge that measures approximately 60°-0" in total length. The structure is an open deck timber trestle that consists of timber stringers supported on timber bents and piling. The stringers are grouped in two chords of three or four, bolted together, and located below each rail. The backwalls are composed of timber.

Description of work for Bridge 8.9

Install deck anchors on all spans.

Span 1:

- Replace the north backwall and add ballast.
- Replace and extend the northwest ballast wall and add ballast.
- Replace the shim over the bent cap at Bent 0.

Span 3:

- Replace stringer 8 in span 3
- Replace shims under south end of stringers over Bent 3A.
- Install ½" shims under all stringers over Bent 3B.
- Add shims to Posts 1 and 4 on Bent 3A.
- Firmly attach Post 4 Bent 3B to the cap.

BRIDGE 9.7

SBVR 9.7 has 58 spans and crosses over the South Branch of the Potomac River in Hampshire County, WV. The spans are approximately 1211'-6" in total length and are arranged as follows:

Span 1 and Spans 36-40 are composed of steel girders supported on steel bents and piling. There is single wide flange steel girder located below each rail. The steel members are unpainted weathering steel.

Spans 2-35 and Spans 41-46 are composed of timber trestles consisting of timber stringers supported on timber bents and piling. The timber stringers are grouped in two chords of three or four, bolted together, and located below each rail.

Spans 47 and 48 are composed of steel rolled stringers supported on steel bents. There are three stringers located below each rail. The stringers are painted while the bents are unpainted weathering steel.

Spans 49-58 are composed of steel rolled stringers supported on cut stone masonry piers or timber post bents with concrete foundations. There are three wide flange, steel stringers below each rail. The stringers have been painted.

The entire bridge has an open deck.

Description of work for Bridge 9.7

Remove logs and debris against the piers in the main channel.

Span 15:

• Repair Pile 6 on Bent 15.

Span 23:

- Repair Pile 1 in Bent 23
- Repair Pile 3 in Bent 23

Span 27:

- Repair Piles 3 and 6
- Replace cap on Bent 27

Span 36:

- Replace all 29 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 37:

- Replace all 29 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 38:

- Replace all 29 ties -8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 41:

• Add shims to all Stringers at Bent 40

Span 50:

- Replace all 33 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 52:

- Replace all 33 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 56:

- Replace all 33 ties -8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 57:

- Replace all 33 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

Span 58:

- Replace all 33 ties 8" x 8" x 10' at current spacing
- Replace timber outer guard rail

BRIDGE 10.3

SBVR 10.3 is a seven span structure crossing over a farm road in Hampshire County, WV. The spans are approximately 75'-9" in total length. The structure is an open deck timber trestle that consists of timber stringers supported on timber bents. Some of the bents have concrete foundations. The stringers are grouped in two chords of three, four or five, bolted together and located below each rail. The backwalls are composed of timber.

Description of work for Bridge 10.3

Span 1:

Replace Post 4 on Bent 1

Span 4:

- Replace Stringer 2
- Replace Stringer 4

Span 7:

- Replace Stringer 6
- Reset cap and shim Stringers 1-3 over Bent 7
- Replace south backwall with two 8"x 16"x 22', one 8"x 16"x 16' and one 8"x 8"x 14' timbers

BRIDGE 17.1

SBVR 17.1 is a 19 span structure that crosses over Mill Creek in Hardy County, WV. The total length of the bridge is approximately 230'-9". The structure is an open deck timber trestle consisting of timber stringers supported on timber bents with mud sills or concrete foundations. The stringers are grouped in two chords of three or four, bolted together, and located below each rail. The stringers are a composite type timber. The backwalls and wingwalls are composed of timber.

Description of work for Bridge 17.1

Remove heavy debris that has accumulated on Bents 7 – 16

Span 1:

- Replace 1" shim under Stringer 1 in Bent 1
- Replace shim on Block 1 in Bent 1

Span 4:

Replace Blocks 1, 2, 3, and 4 in Bent 4

Span 8:

• Install 1/2" x 12" x 3' shim under Stringers 1, 2 and 3 in Bent 8

Span 16:

• Tighten loose bolt connections in splice at bottom of Post 5 in Bent 16

BRIDGE 32.8

SBVR 32.8 is a six span structure over McNeil Run in Hardy County, WV. The bridge is approximately 76'-0" in total length. It is an open deck timber trestle that consists of timber stringers supported on timber bents and piling. The stringers are a gluelam type of timber beam. The stringers are grouped in two chords of three, bolted together and located below each rail. The backwalls are timber.

Description of work for Bridge 32.8

Span 3:

Replace north sash bracing on Bent 3

Span 6:

- Cut in new block at top of Pile 2 in Bent 6
- Replace Pile 3 shim in Bent 6
- Replace 3 Blocks under Bent 6 sill
- Replace south timber backwall. (3) 8"x 16"x 20', (1) 8"x 16"x 12' timbers
- Add ballast to south approach

BRIDGE 42.4

SBVR 42.4 is a four span structure that crosses over a drain (lily pond) in Hardy County, WV. The bridge is approximately 45'-9" in total length. It is an open deck timber trestle consisting of timber stringers supported on timber piling. The stringers are grouped in two chords of three or four, bolted together, and located below each rail. The backwalls and wingwalls are composed of timber.

Description of work for Bridge 42.4

Span 1:

- Replace Stringer 3
- Replace Stringer 5 over Bent 1
- Replace Stringer 7

Spans 3 & 4:

- Replace Stringer 1 over Bent 3 & Bent 4
- Replace the severely rotted bottom timbers of south abutment
- Replace the severely rotted south wingwalls

WEST VIRGINIA CENTRAL RAILROAD - (3 BRIDGES)

BRIDGE 25.6

WVCR 25.6 is a five span structure that crosses the Tygart Valley River in Randolph County, WV. The structure is approximately 300'-0" in total length. The superstructure consists of two simply supported built-up riveted steel deck girders supported on cut stone masonry piers and abutments. The girders are located below each rail and have riveted steel cross frame diaphragms and top and bottom flange lateral bracing. The bridge has an open deck.

Description of work for Bridge 25.6

Span 1:

Reset the NW Girder 2 corner bearing shim which is displaced

Span 5:

• Add 3 cubic yards of ballast at end of Span 5

BRIDGE 28.8

WVCR 28.8 is a four span structure that crosses over the Tygart Valley River and Barron Avenue in Randolph County, WV. The bridge measures approximately 221"-0" in total length. The substructure consists of two built-up riveted steel deck girders supported on concrete piers and abutments. The girders are located below each rail and have riveted steel cross frame diaphragms. The bridge has an open deck with a grated walkway with a handrail consisting of wood posts and metal pipe railing. All substructure components are constructed of concrete.

Description of work for Bridge 28.8

Span 2:

• Clean and paint the top lateral bracing gusset plates on Span 2

Span 3:

 Reattach the two cross frame brace members at the NW end of Span 3 with three high strength bolts each

Span 4:

Replace two missing anchor bolts at SE corner of Span 4, reset bearing plate shim

BRIDGE 43.2

WVCR 43.2 crosses over Lower Pond Lick in Randolph County, WV. The bridge has a single span approximately 18'-0" in total length. The bridge consists of three steel deck stringers per rail (total of six) supported on concrete wall type abutments with concrete wingwalls. The stringers are rolled steel beams with welded steel diaphragms at both abutments and at midspan. Steel bearing shims are located under the beams which sit on rail grillage type bearings. The bridge has an open deck.

Description of work for Bridge 43.2

- Provide a 17" x 17" x 7/8" shim under the Stringer 3 bearing at the north end.
- Remove the debris accumulation in the stream under the bridge

CONDUCT OF WORK

Bridge Tie Installation on Bridge 9.7: On steel spans, every third tie will be anchored to the top of the girder flanges with new, galvanized ¾" hook bolts, nuts and washers. On timber spans, every third tie will be fastened to each stringer chord with a ¾" x 12" washer head drive spike. No more than 8 to 10 ties may be removed at one time due to the CWR. New ties will be shifted as needed to eliminate bunching that has occurred with the existing ties.

Timber Outer Guard Rail: The outer guard rails shall be placed with the inside edge 48 ½" from the centerline of the track. The timber shall be anchored to each tie with 3/4" x 10" washer head drive spikes. The ¾" holes for the drive spikes shall be drilled through the guard rails only and the holes placed in alternate patterns over each tie, three inches (3") inside the edge of the timber. See attached drawing. At the ends of each span, the outer guard rail shall end on the last tie of the span to allow structure expansion and shall not be connected to the backwall or approach tie. Guard rails shall be notched in the field as necessary to clear heads of the hook bolts.

Inner Guard Rail: The inner guard rail shall be reused. It will be spiked to each tie with two spikes per rail, without plates, and will be fully bolted.

Running Rails: Existing ties plates will be re-used with new ¼" thick solid neoprene (no fabric) tie pads between the tie plates and bridge ties. Rails will be spiked to 56 ½" gage with new, 6" cut spikes. They will be spiked to proper alinement without any irregularities in curved or tangent portions. Contractor will be responsible to adjust rail as necessary to eliminate stress that develops as a result of the tie replacement. Spiking pattern will be six spikes per plate. Rails will be box anchored to all ties that are fastened to Bridge 9.7. The existing anchors may be reinstalled.

The contractor shall comply with all safety rules and regulations as required by the Federal Railroad Administration, SBVR, WVCR and other parties as applicable.

The SBVR normally operates freight trains Monday through Friday. These trains will be rescheduled during this project to provide the contractor with an eight-hour window during daylight hours without traffic. Freight trains do not normally operate on the weekends. The SBVR reserves the right to run at any time should an emergency situation develop. An excursion train operated by an outside party begins its season in May. It typically operates on Saturdays and holidays. The contractor must have the track available for safe operation of a train at the end of each day. The SBVR and contractor must coordinate all work to safely continue freight operation. An SBVR employee will obtain the necessary work authorities and provide radio communications with the SBVR office for the contractor when working on the SBVR bridges.

The WVCR freight trains normally run from MP 0 to 29. During late winter and spring, freight trains typically operate five days a week. Excursion trains run weekends thru Memorial Day, and

Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday during June. Additional excursions may be scheduled during weekdays or weekends on an as needed basis. Contractor and operator will coordinate schedules so the track can be made safe for train traffic. Contractor will need to coordinate work with the Durbin & Greenbrier Valley Railroad, the operator of the WVCR. Contact for track access is Mark Smith, 304-642-3050 or wwctrack@yahoo.com.

All contract employees that will be working on the WVCR will have to participate in an on-track safety class prior to beginning work on this railroad. The contractor will also be responsible to have a radio programmed with the Durbin & Greenbrier Valley Railroad's frequency. Each work group must have a radio for communication. The radio must be a minimum of 40 watts. The contractor can get a radio from Hammicks Radios, 304-636-6210 and have it programmed with the same frequency as the DGVR. Each work crew must be equipped with a radio stationed to road channel 160.455. Cell service is limited so a radio is required for all crews.

All work for both railroads is subject to inspection by the SRA, SBVR and WVCR.

There will be a mandatory pre-construction meeting held with the successful contractor prior to the start of work. This meeting will be with SRA, SBVR, WVCR employees and the project manager for the projects. This meeting will assure that everyone understands the entire scope of work as outlined in the awarded purchase order. Also, it will be mandatory that a weekly status report be submitted to the SRA. This report will be signed by the contractor and railroad representative and will list the work completed for the week. A final inspection of all completed work will be conducted by the contractor, the SRA, SBVR and WVCR to assure all work is completed as stated in the specifications. Final payment will be withheld until this inspection is complete.

Contractor will use Heavy & Highway Construction Rates as established for the counties were the work will take place. These rates are pursuant to WV Code § 21-5A, et. Seq. and are available at www.wvsos.com/adlaw/wagerates. Contractor will be responsible for submitting certified payrolls to the SRA.

Contractor will be responsible for clean-up of the work site. All debris and refuse will be removed from the WVCR and SBVR properties and disposed of properly.

The completion date for this project is June 18, 2010. The cost to the SBVR for the administration of the contract as well as train delays that will be incurred after that date make it necessary for the agency to assess liquidated damages against the contractor for each calendar day any work remains uncompleted after that date. The cost will be \$500.00 per day.

MATERIALS

The contractor will provide all materials for this bridge work.

All materials shall be in accordance with American Railway Engineering and Maintenance Association (AREMA) guidelines.

Bridge Ties will be new (223) 8" x 8" x 10'-0 Dense Structural 65 Southern Yellow Pine, creosote pressure-treated to 10# or refusal.

Timber outer guard rails shall be 4" x 8" Southern Yellow Pine creosote pressure-treated to 12# retention or refusal.

The contractor will prepare the dapping plans for ties installed on the steel spans of Bridge 9.7. These ties will be dapped to at least 1/2" and no more than ½" wider than flange width. Timber outer guard rails will be sized to fit all the various spans of each bridge.

Bridge Timber will be Dense Structural 65 Southern Yellow Pine. Treatment of bridge timbers shall be 8-pound retention 60% Creosote -40/% coal tar preservative applied in accordance with AREMA specifications. A preservative/sealant will be applied to the cut ends of timber pieces.

Treated tie plugs, bolts, anchors and new cut track spikes (5/8" x 6") must conform to AREMA specifications.

Ballast shall be crushed stone or slag and shall conform to the current AREMA "Specifications of Prepared Stone, Slag, and Gravel Ballast". Size of ballast shall be AREMA #3 as indicated below:


BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

Interested bidders must attend a mandatory prebid meeting on both railroads. The prebid for the SBVR bridges will be February 24, 2010 at 10:00 am at the SBVR office in Moorefield. The prebid meeting for the WVCR bridges will be February 25, 2010 at 10:00 am at the Elkins Depot in Elkins, WV. These meetings include an inspection trip to the bridges. Bidders must provide their own hy-rail equipment or make arrangements with other potential vendors to ride with them if they are interested in seeing the bridges. Questions prior to the prebid inspection must be submitted in writing and will be addressed at the meeting. Please email any questions to Frank Whittaker at Frank.m.whittaker@wv.gov. ALL questions prior to the prebid inspection and all questions after the prebid inspection are to go to Frank Whittaker at the Purchasing Division. Other than questions addressed the days of the prebid meetings, contractors are not to contact the State Rail Authority directly.

The contractor must have previous experience with timber and steel railroad bridge repair and gabion wall installation. The SRA retains the right to require references of past experience prior to award.

Bids should be submitted as lumps sum amounts separated by railroad. The low bid will be determined by the total of both projects. Bids are to include all costs associated with the projects.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
