In determining total cost for a project, PFM undertakes a specific analysis of the required tasks to provide the desired deliverables and makes an informed estimate of the level of staff – and staff time – necessary to accomplish the specific task. PFM also provides different hourly rates for its staff based on their levels of experience and responsibility.

Project managers and senior project staff (Managing Directors, Directors and Senior Managing Consultants) are billed, for project purposes, at \$225 an hour. Project key staff (Consultants) is billed at \$200 an hour. Research Assistants and Administrative Personnel are billed at \$100 an hour. In all cases, these are inclusive rates – meaning all expense, including travel, lodging and meals – are built into the rates.

Based on the projected hours to accomplish key aspects of the project, the following table breaks out our cost assumption into greater detail:
